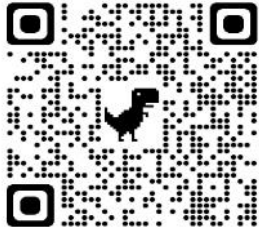

**50 DAYS OF EASTER**

The Liturgical Season of Easter lasts for 50 days, coming to an end on Pentecost Sunday when the promised Holy Spirit comes, and the Catholic Church celebrates its birthday.

We are so grateful for the great celebration of the Risen Lord. What a joy and blessing to see so many people "pouring in" to the Church for each Mass!!! It was a joy also to have three adults Baptized, receive Confirmation and Holy Communion and one young man who has been Methodist and became Catholic during the Vigil. He professed his faith in the Catholic Church's beliefs and teachings, received Confirmation and received the Eucharist. We again express our gratitude to all who in any way helped to prepare for this beautiful celebration. We thank Bobby Consuegra for the way that he so beautifully prayed in chant the Exsultet.

**BLESSED HOLY WATER**

During the Easter Vigil many bottles of water were blessed and are still available after Mass. Having holy water in the home has been a long Christian tradition. A donation would be greatly appreciated.

**DIOCESAN CELEBRATION OF THE EUCHRISTIC REVIVAL**

A friendly reminder that Saturday, April 20th, is creeping up! As soon as possible, we send the names, telephone numbers, and emails of those who plan to attend this great celebration. Entrance is free, but this information is necessary. No one will be allowed entrance who does not have a ticket. Tickets will not be distributed until the above information has been given.

As we have explained, this Diocesan Celebration is our Diocesan participation in the celebration of all the dioceses in the United States in July in Indianapolis. Processions from the four corners of the United States will all head for this great celebration.

The USCCB (United States Catholic Conference of Bishops) called for this three-year Eucharistic Revival as a way to "reinvigorate" our sincere belief that JESUS CHRIST IS TRULY PRESENT IN THE CONSECRATED HOST. Recent surveys have been very disturbing; such a high percentage of Catholics indicated that they do not believe in the Real Presence of Jesus! We know that Christians who are not Catholic, believe that the Eucharist is a sign of the presence of Jesus. However, it is our Catholic faith, since Jesus gave us Himself at the Last Supper, that each time that the priest repeats Jesus' words at the Last Supper, it is truly JESUS.

**DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY**

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. St. John Paul II established this feast in the year 2000. He canonized St. Faustina as the first Saint of this millennium. The Divine Mercy devotion is Jesus' message of mercy revealed to St. Faustina Kowalski, a humble nun from Poland. This devotion has become stronger and stronger. There are novena prayers for nine days before the feast, beginning on Good Friday. Unlike other novenas, where people ask for something from God through the intercession of His Holy Saints, the Divine Mercy Novena is intended to be prayed for graces and/or salvation to be given to other people. Jesus gave St. Faustina an intention to pray for on each day of the Novena, saving for the last day the most difficult intention of all, the lukewarm and indifferent of whom He said: "These souls cause Me more suffering than any others."

Jesus asked St. Faustina to be the messenger of God's mercy to a world wounded by war, division, and sin. Jesus told St. Faustina to have this image painted to remind everyone about God's great mercy and forgiveness of sin, to always trust in the love and mercy of God and to seek His forgiveness through the Sacrament of Reconciliation when we have failed to love God and our neighbor. The words on the bottom of the image are, "Jesus, I trust in You!"

The Divine Mercy image is the message of the Risen Jesus Christ extending to all of us His greeting of peace. The two rays of light shining from His wounded side—one red, and one white—are the blood and water which flowed from Jesus, pierced by the sword when He was crucified on the cross. These rays represent the Sacraments of the Eucharist and Baptism. By Jesus' sacrifice of love, by offering His life for our sins, He brought us back into friendship with God our Father.

There will be envelopes of small Divine Mercy Chaplet prayers at all the entrances to the Church today.

### **CELEBRACIÓN DIOCESANA DEL RENACIMIENTO EUCARÍSTICO**

Un amistoso recordatorio de que el sábado, 20 de abril, ¡se acerca! Tan pronto como sea posible, enviamos los nombres, números de teléfono y correos electrónicos de aquellos que planean asistir a esta gran celebración. La entrada es gratuita, pero esta información es necesaria. No se permitirá la entrada a nadie que no tenga entrada. No se distribuirán entradas hasta que no se haya facilitado la información anterior.

Como hemos explicado, esta Celebración Diocesana es nuestra participación Diocesana en la celebración de todas las diócesis de los Estados Unidos en Julio en Indianápolis. Procesiones de las cuatro esquinas de los Estados Unidos se dirigirán a esta gran celebración.

La USCCB (Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos) hizo un llamado para este Reavivamiento Eucarístico de tres años como una manera de "revigorizar" nuestra creencia sincera de que JESUCRISTO ESTÁ VERDADERAMENTE PRESENTE EN LA HOSTENEDÍA CONSECRADA. Encuestas recientes han sido muy preocupantes; ¡un porcentaje tan alto de católicos indicaron que no creen en la Presencia Real de Jesús! Sabemos que los cristianos que no son católicos, creen que la Eucaristía es un signo de la presencia de Jesús. Sin embargo, es nuestra fe católica, ya que Jesús se entregó a sí mismo en la Última Cena, que cada vez que el sacerdote repite las palabras de Jesús en la Última Cena, es verdaderamente JESUS.

### **DOMINGO DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA**

Hoy es el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. San Juan Pablo II estableció esta fiesta en el año 2000. Canonizó a Santa Faustina como la primera Santa de este milenio. La devoción a la Divina Misericordia es el mensaje de misericordia de Jesús revelado a Santa Faustina Kowalski, una humilde monja de Polonia. Esta devoción se ha hecho cada vez más fuerte. Se reza una novena durante nueve días antes de la fiesta, que comienza el Viernes Santo. A diferencia de otras novenas, en las que se pide algo a Dios por intercesión de sus santos, en la Novena de la Divina Misericordia se reza para que se concedan gracias y/o la salvación a otras personas. Jesús dio a Santa Faustina una intención por la que rezar cada día de la Novena, reservando para el último día la intención más difícil de todas, los tibios e indiferentes de los que dijo: "Estas almas me causan más sufrimientos que las demás".

Jesús pidió a Santa Faustina que fuera mensajera de la misericordia de Dios para un mundo herido por la guerra, la división y el pecado. Jesús dijo a Santa Faustina que mandara pintar esta imagen para recordar a todos la gran misericordia de Dios y el perdón de los pecados, para confiar siempre en el amor y la misericordia de Dios y para buscar su perdón a través del sacramento de la Reconciliación cuando hayamos faltado al amor a Dios y al prójimo. Las palabras en la parte inferior de la imagen son: "¡Jesús, confío en Ti!".

La imagen de la Divina Misericordia es el mensaje de Jesucristo resucitado que nos extiende a todos su saludo de paz. Los dos rayos de luz que brillan desde su costado herido -uno rojo y otro blanco- son la sangre y el agua que brotaron de Jesús, atravesado por la espada cuando fue crucificado en la cruz. Estos rayos representan los sacramentos de la Eucaristía y del Bautismo. Por el sacrificio de amor de Jesús, al ofrecer su vida por nuestros pecados, nos devolvió la amistad con Dios, nuestro Padre.

Hoy habrá sobres con pequeñas oraciones de la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia en todas las entradas de la Iglesia.

**SUNDAY, APRIL 7, 2024 GOSPEL JN 20:19-31****A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN**

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." Thomas, called Didymus, one of the Twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples said to him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nailmarks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." Now a week later his disciples were again inside and Thomas was with them. Jesus came, although the doors were locked, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe." Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name.

**DOMINGO, 7 DE ABRIL 2024, EVANGELIO 20,1-9****LECTURA DEL SANTO EVANGELIO SEGUN SAN JUAN**

Al anochecer del día de la resurrección, estando cerradas las puertas de la casa donde se hallaban los discípulos, por miedo a los judíos, se presentó Jesús en medio de ellos y les dijo: "La paz esté con ustedes". Dicho esto, les mostró las manos y el costado. Cuando los discípulos vieron al Señor, se llenaron de alegría. De nuevo les dijo Jesús: "La paz esté con ustedes. Como el Padre me ha enviado, así también los envío yo". Después de decir esto, sopló sobre ellos y les dijo: "Reciban el Espíritu Santo. A los que les perdonen los pecados, les quedarán perdonados; y a los que no se los perdonen, les quedarán sin perdonar".

Tomás, uno de los Doce, a quien llamaban el Gemelo, no estaba con ellos cuando vino Jesús, y los otros discípulos le decían: "Hemos visto al Señor". Pero él les contestó: "Si no veo en sus manos la señal de los clavos y si no meto mi dedo en los agujeros de los clavos y no meto mi mano en su costado, no creeré". Ocho días después, estaban reunidos los discípulos a puerta cerrada y Tomás estaba con ellos. Jesús se presentó de nuevo en medio de ellos y les dijo: "La paz esté con ustedes". Luego le dijo a Tomás: "Aquí están mis manos; acerca tu dedo. Trae acá tu mano, métela en mi costado y no sigas dudando, sino cree".

Tomás le respondió: "¡Señor mío y Dios mío!" Jesús añadió: "Tú crees porque me has visto; dichosos los que creen sin haber visto". Otros muchos signos hizo Jesús en presencia de sus discípulos, pero no están escritos en este libro. Se escribieron éstas para que ustedes crean que Jesús es el Mesías, el Hijo de Dios, y para que, creyendo, tengan vida en su nombre.

# GOSPEL REFLECTION

- Brave, honest Thomas had gone off to grieve on his own, so he missed that meeting with the Lord. I can taste some of his isolation and resentment in his Unless.... I will not believe. I have suffered in this way when I isolated myself from the community of faith. It is when I am stunned by sorrow that I most need the company of friends and the support of faith.
- Thomas was a modern man, finding faith hard, like many people today. He was let down by the others who ran away, the leader denied Jesus, his trust in the group of apostles had been abused. He didn't want much more to do with them. He had got tired of it all. He wanted to believe but needed a sort of proof. But faith grows within a community. That's why we baptise children, because faith grows from the beginning of life. We find growth in our faith through the community - for example, in the Mass, shared rosary, sharing our faith in a group, a good spiritual book, sharing our doubts but never closing the door to Jesus, sharing our faith in thanks for what our faith gives us.
- In community, the disciples found faith in the risen Christ. Thomas, for some reason, was not with them when the Lord came. Separated from the community, he found faith more difficult. Faith in the Lord, while personal, is not a private affair. In the faith of one, the faith of another may be strengthened. Formation in faith for the disciples had its communal experience - together they learned and found faith in the Lord.
- The risen Jesus penetrates the disciples' defences, overcomes their fears, and brings them joy. I ask him to pass through all my security systems and liberate me from whatever prevents me from 'having life and having it in all its fullness'.
- Jesus always brings peace and reconciliation. Saint Augustine called peace 'the tranquillity of order', meaning order in my relationships with God, with other people and within myself. Where is there lack of peace in my life? Who do I need to make peace with? Do I make space to experience God's forgiveness and gift of peace? I ask for his peace so that I may bring others peace.
- How did the others feel when Thomas challenged their testimony? Watch with them when Jesus comes to Thomas. Do they sympathise? Are they a little smug, even judgmental? Perhaps there is a lot of Thomas in me.
