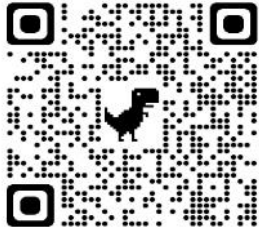

### **FEAST OF THE HOLY TRINITY**

This great mystery of the Holy Trinity teaches us that there are distinct Persons in one God, sharing the same Divine Nature. For us this is a Mystery of our faith that is not easy to grasp. But we believe in this Mystery because Jesus who is God taught it clearly, the Gospel writers have recorded it, the Fathers of the Church tried to explain it and the Councils of Nicaea and Constantinople defined it as dogma of Christian Faith. Evagrius of Pontus, a Greek monk of the 4th century who came from what is now Turkey in Asia and later lived out his vocation in Egypt said, "God cannot be grasped by the mind, if God could be grasped, God would not be God."

All prayers in the Church begin in the Name of the Holy Trinity and end glorifying the Trinity. All Sacraments are administered (we are baptized, confirmed, anointed, our sins are forgiven, our marriage blessed, and our Bishops, priests and deacons ordained) in the name of the Holy Trinity. The doctrine of the Trinity underlies all major feasts, including Christmas, Epiphany, Good Friday, Easter, Ascension and Pentecost. Today's readings convey the fundamental mystery that the Triune God reaches out to people in love, seeking the deepest communion with them. Next week's bulletin will share some reflections on the treasure we have in the Sign of the Cross and in the way that we cross ourselves as we pray it.

### **PRAYER FOR PEACE**

Pope Francis has been pleading that the whole world join in intense prayer for world peace. We are all aware of how much the world is in need of peace. As one of our responses to this plea, the entire parish of St. Nicholas of Tolentine Church will endeavor to come together, FILL OUR CHURCH with children, youth, and adults to pray the living rosary inside of our church. We will need 53 persons to form this living rosary. Remember when Mary appeared in Fatima, Portugal, to three young children, she asked them to pray for peace. We invite everyone who may wish to bring to this prayer any statue or plaque of Mary that you may have. Mary's intercession is powerful!!! This will begin on Friday May 31st at 6:30pm with the living rosary followed immediately by the Mass. Please help us spread the word throughout the parish, our various groups, our ministries, etc.

### **FIESTA DE LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD**

Este gran misterio de la Santísima Trinidad nos enseña que hay distintas Personas en un solo Dios, que comparten la misma naturaleza divina. Para nosotros es un Misterio de nuestra fe que no es fácil de comprender. Pero creemos en este Misterio porque Jesús, que es Dios, lo enseñó claramente, los evangelistas lo han recogido, los Padres de la Iglesia trataron de explicarlo y los Concilios de Nicea y Constantinopla lo definieron como dogma de fe cristiana. Evagrio de Ponto, un monje griego del siglo IV que procedía de lo que hoy es Turquía, en Asia, y más tarde vivió su vocación en Egipto, dijo: "Dios no puede ser captado por la mente, Si Dios pudiera ser captado, Dios no sería Dios".

Todas las oraciones en la Iglesia comienzan en el Nombre de la Santísima Trinidad y terminan glorificando a la Trinidad. Todos los Sacramentos son administrados (somos bautizados, confirmados, ungidos, nuestros pecados son perdonados, nuestro matrimonio bendecido, y nuestros Obispos, sacerdotes y diáconos ordenados) en el nombre de la Santísima Trinidad. La doctrina de la Trinidad subyace en todas las fiestas importantes, como Navidad, Epifanía, Viernes Santo, Pascua, Ascensión y Pentecostés. Las lecturas de hoy transmiten el misterio fundamental de que el Dios Trino se acerca a las personas con amor, buscando la comunión más profunda con ellas. 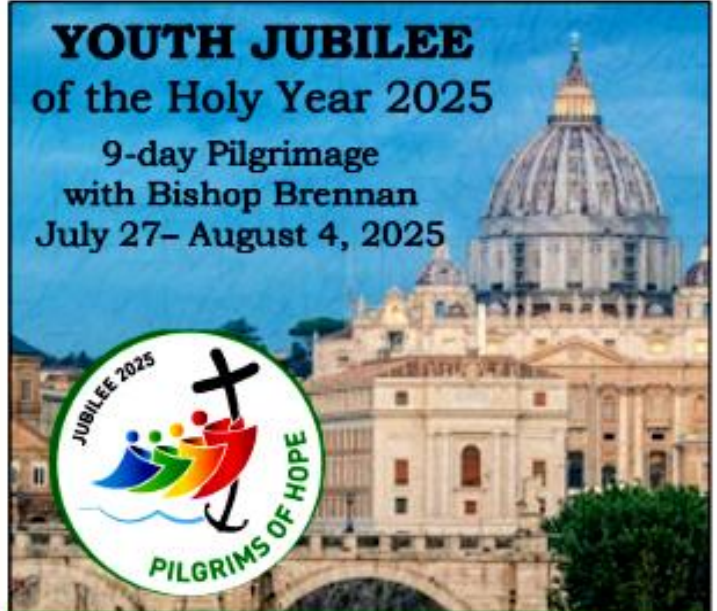
