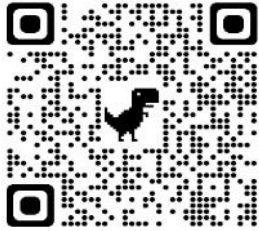

FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY

August 15th is the Feast of the Assumption of Mary. It is one of the eight days of obligation for Catholics which means that like each Sunday, we are expected to participate in the celebration of Holy Mass.

That we may better understand the meaning of this feast, let us refer to the Feast of the Immaculate Conception that is celebrated on December 8th which is also one of the eight days of obligation for Catholics. The meaning of this feast is often confusing for many. Some people think that the meaning of this feast is that Mary was not conceived in the ordinary way. No, she had biological parents, Joaquim and Ann. Whereas Mary conceived Jesus through the power of the Holy Spirit. As we know, Jesus' conception was different.

What the Immaculate Conception means is that from the very moment that Mary was conceived in Ann's womb, she was free from original sin. We know that all of us come into this world with original sin, the consequence of Adam and Eve's sin of disobedience. Because God has no limitations, God knew from the very moment that Mary was conceived that she was going to be the Mother of the Promised Messiah. Therefore, in God's plan she anticipated what you and I receive through our baptism. Original sin is taken away and we begin to share in God's divine life within us. Mary had this from the first moment of her conception.

Another consequence of original sin is experiencing our physical death before we can enter into the fullness of our new life. And not until Jesus comes to earth at the end of time, will our bodies rise, be united with our souls, and then experience the new life. Mary has been given this privilege; she is already in heaven body and soul. This is what the Church celebrates on August 15th.

SUNDAY, AUGUST 11, 2024 GOSPEL JN 6:41-51**A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN**

The Jews murmured about Jesus because he said, "I am the bread that came down from heaven, " and they said, "Is this not Jesus, the son of Joseph? Do we not know his father and mother? 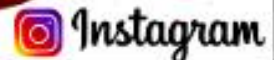
