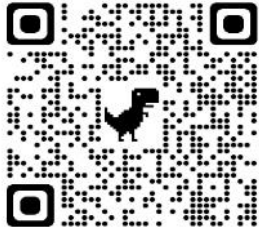

OUR GREAT PARISH FEAST OF ST. NICHOLAS OF TOLENTINE

We eagerly look forward to this celebration beginning with the celebration of the Holy Mass at 5:00 pm and then continuing in Tolentine Hall with our parish feast. You may still place the names of your sick and beloved deceased in the basket in front of the pulpit. They all will be remembered in a special way during the Masses. The drawing of the 50/50 raffle will take place after the 12:15 pm Mass here in the Church. Tickets are still available at all of the entrances to the Church.

NEW YEAR OF THE FAITH FORMATION CLASSES

The third Sunday of September is known as the national Catechetical Sunday which marks the first day of the Faith Formation for 2024-2025. The catechists will receive a special blessing as they recommit themselves to serve in this very important ministry. All our parents will also receive a special blessing. We need to work together, parents and catechists, to help our children come to know our loving God and our Catholic faith.

Therefore, next Sunday, the classes will begin at 9:00 am in the Faith Formation Center. At 10:45 as a class we all go to Mass together. The parents will join us there.

After all the Masses today and during this coming week, there will be registration for new students and re-registration for those continuing their Faith Formation.

The sessions for adults seeking Baptism, Eucharist, and/or Confirmation will begin on Sunday, September 22nd at 10:30 am in the Faith Formation Center.

FEAST OF THE TRIUMPH OF THE CROSS

Saturday, September 14th, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Triumph of the Cross of Christ. The readings for this Feast are an example of what St. Augustine is so well-known for: in the Old Testament is concealed what is fully revealed in the New Testament. The Israelites who had been delivered from their terrible treatment in Egypt are tired and disgusted with what they are experiencing as they journey through the desert to the Promised Land. They complain to Moses that there is no food or water. In punishment the Lord sent among the people saraph serpents, which bit the people so that many of them died. Then the people came to Moses again realizing they had sinned by complaining against the Lord. They begged Moses to pray that the Lord would take away the serpents. Moses prayed and the Lord said to him: "Make a saraph and mount it on a pole, and if anyone who has been bitten looks at it, he will recover." Then Moses complied and those who had been bitten by a serpent looked at the bronze serpent, they recovered. Here we have the image of the bronze serpent to which Jesus referred in His conversation with Nicodemus in the Gospel for this feast. The Lord Himself revealed the meaning of this image saying: "The Son of Man must be lifted up as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so that everyone who believes may have eternal life in him" (John 3:14-14).

In the book of Genesis the serpent was a symbol of the spirit of evil. But now, by a startling reversal, the bronze serpent lifted up in the desert is a figure of Christ lifted up on the Cross. The feast of the Triumph of the Cross recalls to our minds the lifting up of Christ on the Cross on Good Friday which ultimately is what gives us the doorway to eternal life. Because in Him - Christ crucified - is manifested to the full the love of God for the world, for each one of us!

FEAST OF OUR LADY OF SORROWS

The day after the Feast of the Triumph of the Cross, the Church celebrates the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. It is quite fitting that this feast immediately follow the Triumph of the Cross because her feast helps us to reflect on the spiritual martyrdom that she suffered as the Mother of God and her compassion with the sufferings of her Divine Son. I believe that all mothers know something of how much a mother suffers when their children suffer in any way. We can only ponder on the depth of suffering that Mary experienced as she painfully endured what her Son, Jesus, suffered out of pure love for each of us.

FIESTA DEL TRIUNFO DE LA CRUZ

El sábado 14 de septiembre, la Iglesia celebra la fiesta del Triunfo. Las lecturas de esta fiesta son un ejemplo ejemplo de lo que es tan conocido de San Agustín: en el Antiguo Testamento se lo que se revela plenamente en el Nuevo Testamento. Los israelitas que habían sido liberados de su terrible trato en Egipto están cansados y disgustados con lo que están experimentando mientras a través del desierto hacia la Tierra Prometida. Se quejan a Moisés de que no hay comida ni agua. En castigo, el Señor envió entre el serpientes sarafas, que mordieron al pueblo de modo que muchos de ellos murieron. Entonces el pueblo acudió de nuevo a Moisés dándose cuenta de que habían pecado al quejándose contra el Señor. Le rogaron a Moisés que rezara para que el Señor las serpientes. Moisés oró y el Señor le dijo: «Haz un saraph y móntalo en un poste, y si alguien que ha sido mordido lo mira, se recuperará. lo mire, se recuperará». Entonces Moisés obedeció y los que habían sido mordidos por una serpiente miraron a la serpiente de bronce, se recuperaron. Aquí tenemos la imagen de la serpiente de bronce a la que Jesús se refirió en Su conversación con Nicodemos en el Evangelio de esta fiesta. El Señor mismo reveló el significado de esta imagen diciendo: «El Hijo del hombre debe ser levantado como Moisés levantó la serpiente en el desierto, para que todo el que que crea tenga en él vida eterna» (Jn 3,14-14).

En el libro del Génesis, la serpiente era un símbolo del espíritu del mal. Pero ahora, por una sorprendente inversión, la serpiente de bronce levantada en el desierto es una figura de Cristo levantado en la Cruz. La fiesta del Triunfo de la Cruz nos recuerda la elevación de Cristo en la Cruz el Viernes Santo, que, en definitiva, es lo que nos da la salvación. Sólo podemos reflexionar sobre la profundidad del sufrimiento que María dolorosamente lo que su Hijo, Jesús, sufrió por puro amor a cada uno de nosotros.

Again Jesus left the district of Tyre and went by way of Sidon to the Sea of Galilee, into the district of the Decapolis. And people brought to him a deaf man who had a speech impediment and begged him to lay his hand on him. He took him off by himself away from the crowd. He put his finger into the man's ears and, spitting, touched his tongue; then he looked up to heaven and groaned, and said to him, "*Ephphatha!*"— that is, "Be opened!" — And immediately the man's ears were opened, his speech impediment was removed, and he spoke plainly. He ordered them not to tell anyone. But the more he ordered them not to, the more they proclaimed it. They were exceedingly astonished and they said, "He has done all things well. He makes the deaf hear and the mute speak."

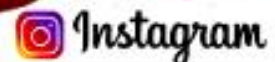
