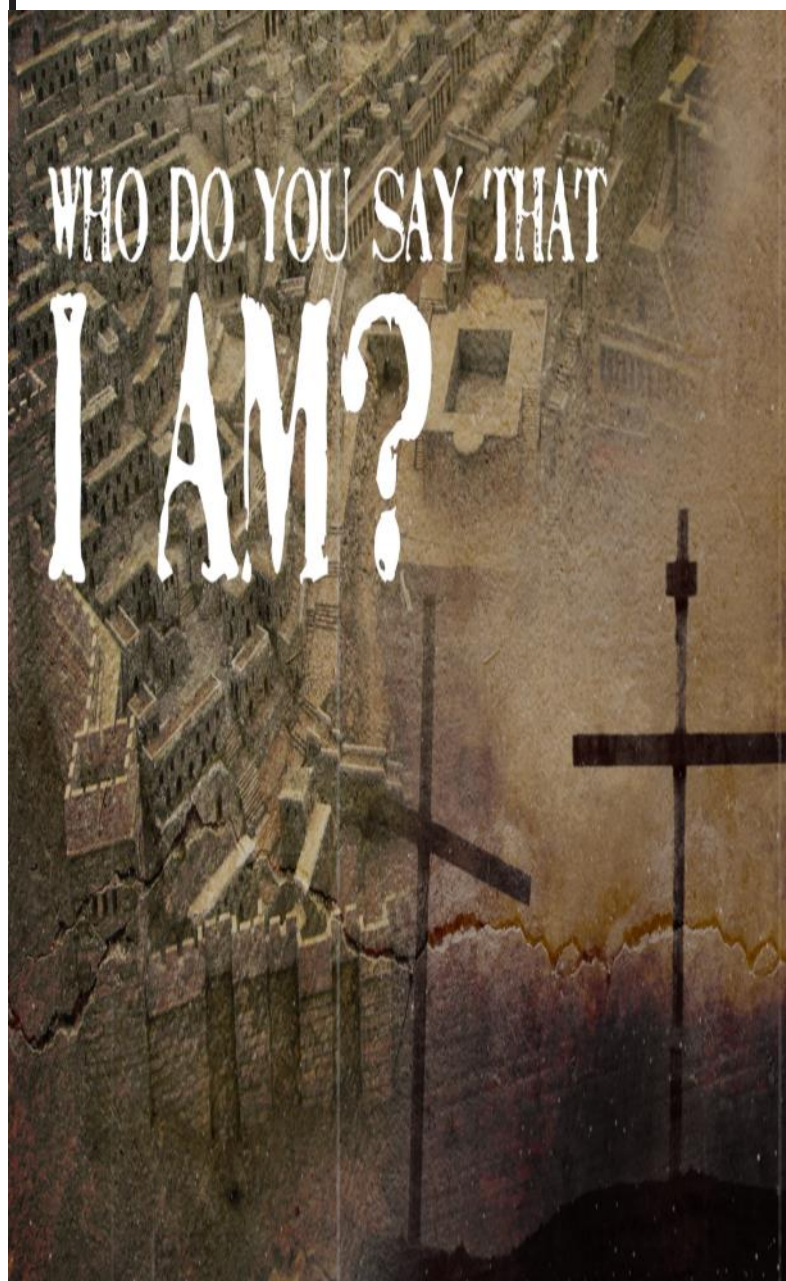

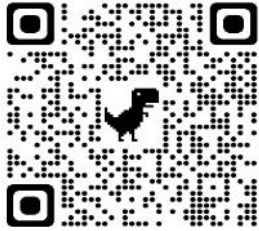

**NATIONAL CATECHETICAL SUNDAY**

The third Sunday of September is National Catechetical Sunday during which the catechists are blessed and commissioned to their ministry. Each year a specific theme is chosen by the USCCB (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops). This year's theme is: "Lord, when did we see you hungry?" Throughout this year, we will be teaching about the Catholic Social Teachings.

It is also the first day for all Faith Formation classes. The students will gather at 9:00am in front of the blue door of the Faith Formation Center. Grade by grade they will be escorted to their specific class.

Many students have not re-registered for this new year. May I once again remind parents that faith formation IS NOT ONLY to prepare for First Communion and then much later for Confirmation. Just as in the normal every day classes in the public school, the children develop and deepen their learning year after year, so too in our faith formation classes to continue to learn about our Catholic Faith and come to know God better and better. There will be a table set up outdoors on Sunday (if the weather permits) or in the DRE's office to register.

**SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 2024 GOSPEL MK 8:27-35****A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ST. MARK**

Jesus and his disciples set out for the villages of Caesarea Philippi. Along the way he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that I am?" They said in reply, "John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others one of the prophets." And he asked them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter said to him in reply, "You are the Christ." Then he warned them not to tell anyone about him. He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer greatly and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and rise after three days. He spoke this openly. Then Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. At this he turned around and, looking at his disciples, rebuked Peter and said, "Get behind me, Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do." He summoned the crowd with his disciples and said to them, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it."



**DOMINGO, 15 DE SEPTIEMBRE 2024, EVANGELIO MC 8,27-35**

**LECTURA DEL SANTO EVANGELIO SEGUN SAN MARCOS**

En aquel tiempo, Jesús y sus discípulos se dirigieron a los poblados de Cesarea de Filipo. Por el camino les hizo esta pregunta: "¿Quién dice la gente que soy yo?" Ellos le contestaron: "Algunos dicen que eres Juan el Bautista; otros, que Elías; y otros, que alguno de los profetas". Entonces él les preguntó: "Y ustedes ¿quién dicen que soy yo?" Pedro le respondió: "Tú eres el Mesías". Y él les ordenó que no se lo dijeran a nadie. Luego se puso a explicarles que era necesario que el Hijo del hombre padeciera mucho, que fuera rechazado por los ancianos, los sumos sacerdotes y los escribas, que fuera entregado a la muerte y resucitara al tercer día. Todo esto lo dijo con entera claridad. Entonces Pedro se lo llevó aparte y trataba de disuadirlo. Jesús se volvió, y mirando a sus discípulos, reprendió a Pedro con estas palabras: "¡Apártate de mí, Satanás! Porque tú no juzgas según Dios, sino según los hombres". Después llamó a la multitud y a sus discípulos, y les dijo: "El que quiera venir conmigo, que renuncie a sí mismo, que cargue con su cruz y que me siga. Pues el que quiera salvar su vida, la perderá; pero el que pierda su vida por mí y por el Evangelio, la salvará".

## **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

- This is a painful scene: first Peter rebukes Jesus, then Jesus rebukes Peter. We can sympathise with Peter, because which of us can bear the thought of our best friend being tortured and killed? But Jesus tells Peter that God's plans are so much bigger than he imagines.
- Someone has said that God's dreams come to us several sizes too large! It takes us time to grow into them. What about my inner growth – have I stopped growing at some point, so that God cannot do more creative work with me?
- Lord, let me be open to your unrestricted dreams for me, even though they involve change and pain and ultimately, death. This is the way to eternal joy.
