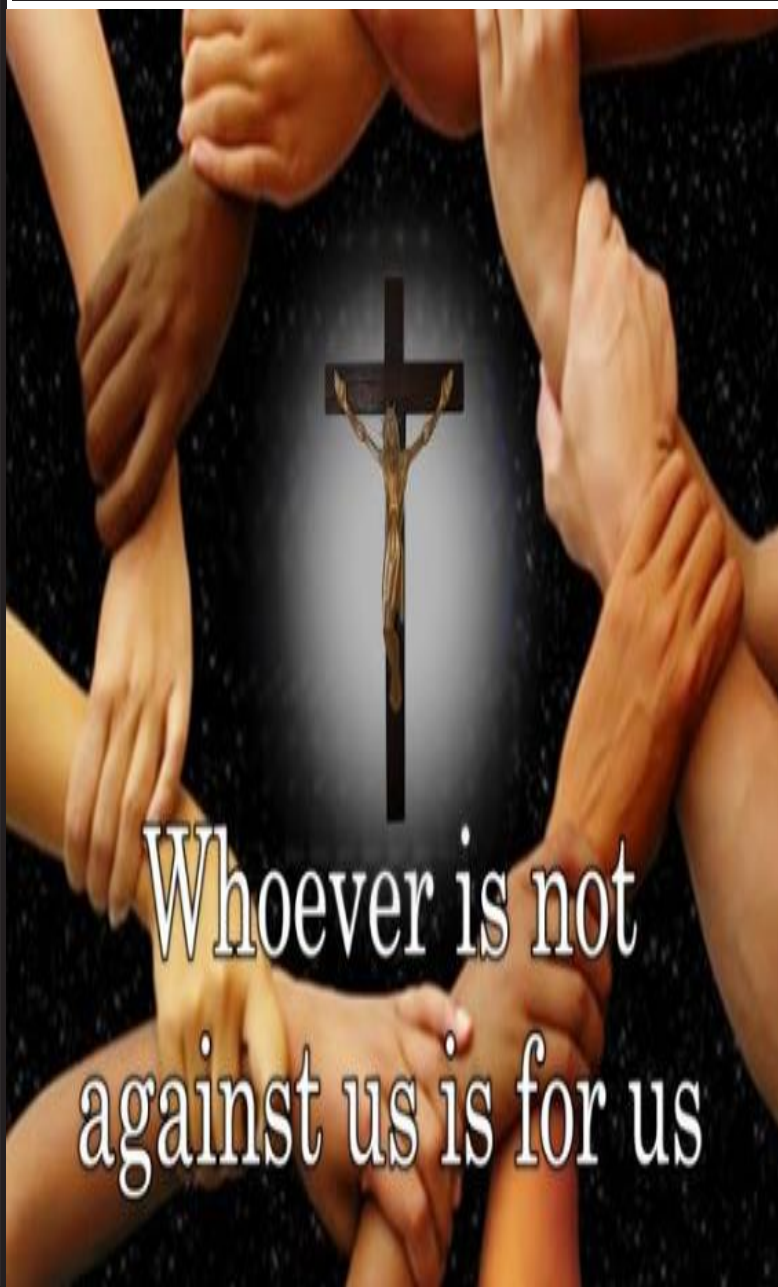

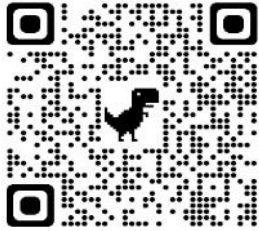

FEAST OF ST. THERESE OF LISIEUX

The feast day of St. Therese of Lisieux is October 1st . St. Therese of Lisieux was a French Discalced Carmelite who was born on January 2nd , 1873, in Alencon, France. Therese's religious name was Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face. She is also known as the Little Flower. Her parents were Louis Martin who was a watchmaker and jeweler and Marie-Azelie Guerin Martin who was a lacemaker. Her mother died of cancer when Therese was only four. There were nine children in the family.

From a very young age, Therese dreamed of being a missionary. Her siblings all became nuns. At the age of 15 she very much wanted to also enter the convent, but the superior said she was too young. She then went to her local bishop to ask him to intervene. When that did not happen, she went to Rome to ask Pope Leo XIII to make her request possible. He told her that she had to accept the decision of the superior who finally did relent and accepted Therese.

St. Therese did not enjoy good health. For less than 10 years she was a nun and died of tuberculosis at the age of 24. However, she came to understand that very few of us are called to do great things but that through small, loving actions, we can also bring God's love to the world. Through her simple teachings, gentle example, and her ardent love for God, she came to share with us what she called "The Little Way". Basically, it is doing all things, no matter how small or seemingly not very important, with great love.

Her prioress asked her to write her life story which is called "The Story of a Soul" which is still available. St. Therese made a promise that "after my death, I will let fall a shower of roses. I will spend my heaven doing good upon earth. I will raise up a mighty host of little saints." There is a belief that when praying to St. Therese and the petition is going to be granted, somehow one unexpectedly receives roses, even in a card. I have had a friend who was extremely devoted to St. Therese and often shared her stories with me. I would like to share something that happened in my life. A very good friend of mine had been diagnosed with cancer and was under treatment back in 2007. I began the Novena of St. Therese asking for healing. During the novena, I and another friend went to Orange, Connecticut to the then Christmas Tree Shop. After my delightful little purchases, we walked quickly to the car because it was raining. As I was about to open my car door, a lady with plastic roses ran toward me, asking me to buy them. I felt an immediate emotion! Yes, I bought them, and I still have them in the prayer corner in my bedroom. My friend was healed, and the cancer has never returned. Thanks be to God!

Pope Pius XI canonized Therese in 1925 and Pope John Paul II declared her a Doctor of the Church in 1997. Pope Francis canonized her father and mother in 2015.

We know that all of us are called to walk in the ways of the Lord which is not always so easy. St. Therese can encourage us to do whatever we do with love. May I encourage each of us to more consciously try to have this mind set!

FEAST OF ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI

October 4th is the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi who is a very well-known and popular saint for many. He lived during the late 12th and 13th centuries in Italy. He was the founder of the Franciscan Order. He is remembered for his generosity to the poor and his willingness to minister to the lepers. What many people recall about St. Francis is his love for animals and nature. We here at St. Nicholas of Tolentine will have the **blessing of animals at 2:00 on Friday, October 4th** . Please bring your animals to the front of our Church was the blessing. Pope Gregory IX pronounced St. Francis a saint in 1228. He also laid the foundation stone for the Basilica of St. Francis in Assisi, Italy.

FIESTA DE SANTA TERESA DE LISIEUX

La fiesta de Santa Teresa de Lisieux es el 1 de octubre. Santa Teresa de Lisieux fue una carmelita descalza francesa que nació el 2 de enero de 1873 en Alençon, Francia. El nombre religioso de Teresa era Teresa de la Niño Jesús y la Santa Faz. También se la conoce como la Pequeña Flor. Sus padres eran Louis Martin, relojero y joyero, y Marie-Azelie Guérin Martin, encajera. Su madre murió de cáncer cuando Therese tenía sólo cuatro años. Había nueve hijas en la familia.

Desde muy pequeña Teresa soñaba ser misionera. Todos sus hermanas se hicieron monjas. A los 15 años tenía muchas ganas de entrar también en el convento, pero la superiora dijo que era demasiado joven. Ella luego fue a su obispo local para pedirle que interviniera. Cuando eso no sucedió, fue a Roma para pedirle al Papa León XIII que hiciera posible su petición. El le dijo que tenía que aceptar la decisión del superior, quien finalmente cedió y aceptó a Teresa.

Santa Teresa no gozaba de buena salud. Durante menos de 10 años fue monja y murió de tuberculosis a los 24 años. Sin embargo, comprendió que muy pocos estamos llamados a hacer grandes cosas pero que a través de pequeñas acciones de amor, también podemos llevar el amor de Dios al mundo. A través de sus sencillas enseñanzas, su gentil ejemplo y su ardiente amor por Dios, vino a compartir con nosotros lo que ella llamó "El Pequeño Camino". Básicamente, es hacer todas las cosas, por pequeñas o aparentemente no muy importantes, con mucho amor.

Su priora le pidió que escribiera la Historia de su vida, llamada "La Historia de un alma", que todavía está disponible. Santa Teresa hizo la promesa de que "después de mi muerte, dejaré caer una lluvia de rosas. Pasaré mi cielo haciendo el bien en la tierra. Levantaré una gran hueste de pequeños santos". Existe la creencia de que cuando se reza a Santa Teresa y se va a conceder la petición, de alguna manera uno recibe rosas inesperadamente, incluso en una tarjeta. Tuve una amiga que era extremadamente devota de Santa Teresa y a menudo compartía sus historias conmigo. Me gustaría compartir algo que pasó en mi vida. A una muy buena amiga mía le habían diagnosticado cáncer y estaba bajo tratamiento en 2007. Comencé la Novena de Santa Teresa pidiendo curación. Durante la novena, otra amiga y yo fuimos a Orange, Connecticut, a la entonces Christmas Tree Shop. Después de mis pequeñas compras encantadoras, caminamos rápidamente hacia el auto porque estaba lloviendo. Cuando estaba a punto de abrir la puerta de mi auto, una señora con rosas de plástico corrió hacia mí pidiéndome que las comprara. ¡Sentí una emoción inmediata! Sí, los compré y todavía los tengo en el rincón de oración de mi dormitorio. Mi amiga fue sanada y el cáncer nunca regresó. ¡Gracias a Dios!

Sabemos que todos estamos llamados a caminar en los caminos del Señor, lo cual no siempre es tan fácil. Santa Teresa puede animarnos a hacer todo lo que hagamos con amor. ¡Puedo animar a cada uno de nosotros a intentar más conscientemente tener esta mentalidad!

FIESTA DE SAN FRANCISCO DE ASSÍSI

El 4 de octubre es la Fiesta de San Francisco de Assísí, un santo muy conocido y popular para muchos. Vivió a finales del siglo XII y XIII en Italia. Fue el fundador de la Orden Franciscana. SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2024 GOSPEL MK 9:38-43**A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ST. MARK**

At that time, John said to Jesus, "Teacher, we saw someone driving out demons in your name, and we tried to prevent him because he does not follow us." Jesus replied, "Do not prevent him. There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me. For whoever is not against us is for us. ST. NICHOLAS OF TOLENTINE, 1245--1305

This Nov. 3, 1743 reliquary contains the blood and bone relics of St. Nicholas.

This reliquary and signed document were created by Bishop Dionysius Pieragostini and prepared by his Secretary Venanbius Mojsinus Ferretti. In 1884 St. Nicholas was proclaimed the Patron St. of the Holy Souls in Purgatory. This reliquary is lovingly gifted on Sept. 10, 2024 to the Parish of St. Nicholas of Tolentino Roman Catholic Church and Academy on the 719th Death Anniversary of St. Nicholas. It was presented to Pastor, Rev. Jovito B. Carongay, Jr., Rev. Noel A. Daduya, Rev. Thomas P. Joseph, Rev. Abraham Mathew, Deacon Thomas Jorge, Mrs. Gloria Scarola, Mr. Steven Acosta, Mrs. Maria Coronel, Mr. Gregory Pirraglia, Mrs. Lorraine White, Mrs. Sonya Vidal, Sr. Alice Michael, Academy Principal Ms. Julissa Gonzalez and the student body. Gifted with eternal love and devotion by Fausto, Emilia, Pedro, Elizabeth, Sophia, Emily, Maria, Angel Senior, Luis, Conception, Angel Diaz Jr. and the entire Diaz, Perez, Corpion and Celek Families. May St. Nicholas protect this Parish and Academy for all time.
