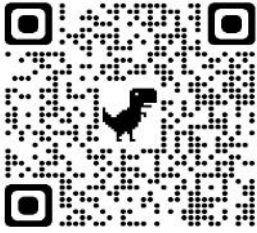

WE NEED ONE ANOTHER'S HELP

Unfortunately, from week to week we are finding broken kneelers in various parts of the Church. This is being caused by banging the kneelers to bring them down, rather than either lowering the kneeler with your hands or with your feet but gently without noise.

When the time comes to lower the kneelers, we are about to enter an essential part of the Liturgy: the consecration when the bread and wine become Jesus' body and blood. It is an extremely sacred moment. There should be extreme reverence as we kneel!

We need one another's help so that each of us can contribute to making our Eucharistic celebration as reverent as possible. The noise we hear as the kneelers are being lowered makes one think we are at a stadium of some sort and not the House of God where Jesus is present in the Tabernacle, day and night. The Tabernacle is to the far right of the sanctuary in the Church with the lit sanctuary red candle overhead to indicate His presence. In our Faith Formation classes we are trying to help our children realize this, but we need the good example of the adults also.

Another way that we can help one another to be as reverent as we can when approaching Holy Communion and when returning from having received Jesus in Holy Communion. Hands in our pockets or swinging arms are not appropriate. Not necessarily folding our hands but clasping our hands can help us be more focused. As we are in line proceeding to receive the Eucharist, we may pray the formal Act of Contrition or pray one in our own words asking Jesus to forgive us and help us to receive Him worthily.

HOSPITALITY SUNDAY

Today, the first Sunday of the month, is Hospitality Sunday in Tolentine Hall after the 9:15 am Mass and the 10:45 Mass. All are welcome.

ADULT SESSIONS

The sessions for adults who are seeking Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and or Confirmation will be on Saturdays at 3:45pm in the Faith Formation Center. However, if this is not convenient due to work schedules, please see me. We will do our best to accommodate your needs. At present Saturdays seem to be the best time and day.

FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATIONS

We continue to accept registrations for the Sunday classes. Many of the children who received their First Holy Communion have not yet returned. This is a serious obligation of the parents. Our children cannot deepen their knowledge of our Faith by limiting their preparation to the two years for First Communion. As I have repeated over and over, no parent would dream of limiting their child's general education in their schools to two years, then take several years off, and return for 7th and 8th grade. We do all we can so that the tuition will not be an obstacle. The children who continue their faith formation from grades 3, 4, 5, and 6 and have received their First Holy Communion, only pay \$30.00 for the year. And should this be an obstacle, please see me.

OCTOBER, THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY

Traditionally October is known as the month of the Rosary. We pray the Rosary every day at 11:30 am before the Mass. When Mary appeared to the three children in Fatima, Portugal, she asked that we pray the Rosary for peace and reparation for so much sin.

We encourage families to pray the Rosary every day or at least one decade of the Rosary each day. Today's world, our families, each of us urgently need the intercession of Mary.

OCTOBER 5th: FEAST OF ST. FAUSTINA

The feast of St. Faustina was on Saturday, October 5th. She is a well-known saint who was born in Poland in 1905 and died on October 5, 1938. She was chosen by Jesus and Mary to be the apostle of divine mercy. Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina on April 30, 2000.

Jesus appeared to Faustina wearing a white robe with red and pale rays from His heart. He asked her to have an image painted according to the pattern that He was showing with the signature, "Jesus, I trust in You." He expressed His desire that this image be venerated. Many Catholics have the devotion to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 3:00pm. The Sunday after Easter is Divine Mercy Sunday. At that time, we will write more details about this great feast and its significance for our spiritual lives.

NECESITAMOS LA AYUDA DE LOS DEMÁS

Desafortunadamente, semana tras semana vamos encontrando reclinatorios rotos en varias partes de la Iglesia. Esto se debe a golpear a los reclinatorios para bajarlos, en lugar de bajarlos con las manos o con los pies, pero suavemente y sin hacer ruido.

Cuando llega el momento de arrodillarse, estamos a punto de entrar en una parte esencial de la Liturgia: la consagración cuando el pan y el vino se convierten en cuerpo y sangre de Jesús. Es un momento extremadamente sagrado. Allí ¡Debe haber extrema reverencia mientras nos arrodillamos!

Necesitamos la ayuda mutua para que cada uno de nosotros pueda contribuir a que nuestra celebración eucarística sea lo más reverente posible. El ruido que escuchamos mientras bajan a los arrodilladores hace pensar que estamos en algún tipo de estadio y no en la Casa de Dios donde Jesús está presente en el Tabernáculo, día y noche. El Tabernáculo está en el extremo derecho del santuario de la Iglesia con la vela roja encendida en lo alto para indicar Su presencia. En nuestras clases de Formación de Fe intentamos ayudar a nuestros niños a darse cuenta de esto, pero también necesitamos el buen ejemplo de los adultos.

Otra forma en la que podemos ayudarnos unos a otros a ser lo más reverentes posible al acercarnos a la Sagrada Comunión y al regresar de haber recibido a Jesús en la Sagrada Comunión. Las manos en los bolsillos o balancear los brazos no son apropiados. No necesariamente cruzar las manos, pero juntarlas puede ayudarnos a estar más concentrados. Mientras estamos en la fila para recibir la Eucaristía, podemos rezar el Acto de Contrición formal o rezar uno con nuestras propias palabras pidiéndole a Jesús que nos perdone y nos ayude a recibirlo dignamente.

DOMINGO DE HOSPITALIDAD

Hoy, el primer domingo del mes, es el Domingo de Hospitalidad en Tolentine Hall después de la Misa de las 9:15 am y la Misa de las 10:45. Todos son bienvenidos.

SESIONES PARA ADULTOS

Las sesiones para adultos que buscan el Bautismo, la Sagrada Eucaristía o la Confirmación serán los sábados a las 3:45 p.m. en el Centro de Formación de Fe. Sin embargo, si esto no es conveniente debido a horarios de trabajo, por favor visítame. Haremos todo lo posible para satisfacer sus necesidades. Actualmente los sábados parecen ser el mejor día y hora.

INSCRIPCIONES DE FORMACIÓN DE FE

Seguimos aceptando inscripciones para las clases dominicales. Muchos de los niños que recibieron su Primera Comunión aún no han regresado. Esta es una obligación grave de los padres. Nuestros hijos no pueden profundizar su conocimiento de nuestra Fe limitando su preparación a los dos años para la Primera Comunión. Como he repetido una y otra vez, a ningún padre se le ocurriría limitar la educación general de sus hijos en sus escuelas a dos años, en lugar de tomarse varios años de descanso y regresar al séptimo y octavo grado. Hacemos todo lo posible para que la matrícula no sea un obstáculo. Los niños que continúan su formación en la fe desde los grados 3, 4, 5 y 6 y han recibido su Primera Comunión, solo pagan \$30.00 por año. Y si esto fuera un obstáculo, por favor visítame.

OCTUBRE, MES DEL ROSARIO

Octubre es tradicionalmente conocido como el mes del Rosario. Rezamos el Rosario todos los días a las 11:30 am antes de la Misa. Cuando María se apareció a los tres niños en Fátima, Portugal, nos pidió que rezáramos el Rosario por la paz y la reparación por tanto pecado.

Alentamos a las familias a rezar el Rosario todos los días o al menos una decena del Rosario cada día. El mundo de hoy, nuestras familias, cada uno de nosotros necesitamos urgentemente la intercesión de María.

5 DE OCTUBRE: FIESTA DE ST. FAUSTINA

La fiesta de Santa Faustina fue el sábado 5 de octubre. Es una conocida santa que nació en Polonia en 1905 y falleció el 5 de octubre de 1938. Fue elegida por Jesús y María para ser apóstol de la divina misericordia. El Papa Juan Pablo II canonizó a Santa Faustina el 30 de abril de 2000.

Jesús se apareció a Faustina vestido con una túnica blanca con rayos rojos y pálidos que salían de su corazón. Le pidió que le pintaran una imagen según el patrón que Él estaba mostrando con la firma: "Jesús, en ti confío". Expresó su deseo de que esta imagen fuera venerada. Muchos católicos tienen la devoción de rezar la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia a las 3:00 p.m. El domingo después de Pascua es el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. En ese momento escribiremos más detalles sobre esta gran fiesta y su significado para nuestra vida espiritual.

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2024 GOSPEL MK 10:2-16**A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ST. MARK**

The Pharisees approached Jesus and asked, "Is it lawful for a husband to divorce his wife?" They were testing him. He said to them in reply, "What did Moses command you?" They replied, "Moses permitted a husband to write a bill of divorce and dismiss her." But Jesus told them, "Because of the hardness of your hearts he wrote you this commandment. But from the beginning of creation, *God made them male and female. For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. So they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, no human being must separate.*" In the house the disciples again questioned Jesus about this. He said to them, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her; and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery." And people were bringing children to him that he might touch them, but the disciples rebuked them. When Jesus saw this he became indignant and said to them, "Let the children come to me; do not prevent them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Amen, I say to you, whoever does not accept the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it." Then he embraced them and blessed them, placing his hands on them.

DOMINGO, 6 DE OCTUBRE 2024, EVANGELIO MC 10,2-16**LECTURA DEL SANTO EVANGELIO SEGUN SAN MARCOS**

En aquel tiempo, se acercaron a Jesús unos fariseos y le preguntaron, para ponerlo a prueba: "¿Le es lícito a un hombre divorciarse de su esposa?" Él les respondió: "¿Qué les prescribió Moisés?" Ellos contestaron: "Moisés nos permitió el divorcio mediante la entrega de un acta de divorcio a la esposa". Jesús les dijo: "Moisés prescribió esto, debido a la dureza del corazón de ustedes. Pero desde el principio, al crearlos, Dios los hizo hombre y mujer. *Por eso dejará el hombre a su padre y a su madre y se unirá a su esposa y serán los dos una sola cosa. De modo que ya no son dos, sino una sola cosa.* Por eso, lo que Dios unió, que no lo separe el hombre". Ya en casa, los discípulos le volvieron a preguntar sobre el asunto. Jesús les dijo: "Si uno se divorcia de su esposa y se casa con otra, comete adulterio contra la primera. Y si ella se divorcia de su marido y se casa con otro, comete adulterio". Después de esto, la gente le llevó a Jesús unos niños para que los tocara, pero los discípulos trataban de impedirlo. Al ver aquello, Jesús se disgustó y les dijo: "Dejen que los niños se acerquen a mí y no se lo impidan, porque el Reino de Dios es de los que son como ellos. Les aseguro que el que no reciba el Reino de Dios como un niño, no entrará en él". Después tomó en brazos a los niños y los bendijo imponiéndoles las manos.
