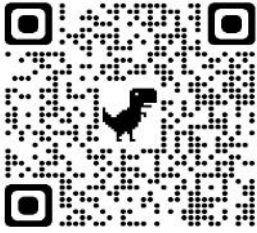

FATIMA'S OCTOBER 13 APPARITION

We recall the apparition of Our Blessed Mother to the three children at Fatima, Portugal in 1917. Jacinta, Lucia, and Francisco suffered very much from the authorities and even from their families because it was believed they were lying. But the children, though so young, were very strong and never faltered in their testimony.

The first apparition was in May. Our Lady asked the children to come on the 13th of every month. Mary's basic message was to pray the rosary, make reparation for sin, and change our lives. She expressed her deep sorrow that Jesus was already very much offended by our sins.

During the July apparition, Mary told the three children that in October she would tell who she is and what she wants. She said that she would then perform a miracle so that all may believe. Again, in her September appearance she reminded them that in October she would perform a miracle so that all may believe.

It is said that 70,000 people gathered in Fatima on that day. On that day, Lucia asked Our Lady what her request was. She said she wanted a chapel built there in her honor. She also repeated something she asked every month, "continue praying the rosary every day." Mary told them that the war (World War I) would end soon, and the soldiers would return to their homes.

Then as promised she identified herself saying "I am the Lady of the Rosary." Then came her admonition that people must amend their lives and ask pardon for their sins. They must not offend Our Lord anymore, for He is already very offended. When Mary appeared in July, she told the children that if people do not refrain from offending God, there would be another and more terrible war (World War II).

As Our Lady was leaving the October 13th apparition, she directed attention to the sun. As eyewitnesses, Jacinta and Francisco's father Ti Marto said it was most extraordinary the sun didn't hurt their eyes. "Everything was still and quiet, and everyone was looking up. Then at a certain moment, the sun appeared to stop spinning. It then began to move and to dance in the sky until it seemed to detach itself from its place and fall upon us. It was a terrible moment."

The miracle was seen and experienced by others far from the Cova. One man wrote how he observed it from nearly 25 miles away. And Father Ignacio Loreco, a nine-year old schoolboy at that time, was 11 miles away. He explained that the children were outside and witnessed "the great Miracle, which one could see quite distinctly from the top of the hill where my village was situated. The sun suddenly seemed to come down in a zizzag, menacing the earth. Terrified, I ran and hid myself among the people, who were weeping and expecting the end of the world at any moment."

Many non-believers converted that day even at a distance. Father Loreco noted, "Near us was an unbeliever who had spent the morning mocking at the simpletons who had gone off to Fatima just to see an ordinary girl. He now seemed to be paralyzed; his eyes fixed on the sun. Afterwards he trembled from head to foot and lifting up his arms fell on his knees in the mud, crying out to Our Lady."

Though these apparitions took place back in 1917, Our Lady's message is true to this very day. She continually asks us to pray the Rosary, to make sacrifices for our own sins and those of the whole world, and to change our lives. We are all on a pilgrimage that began with our baptism and continues day in and day out, as with God's help and especially His sacraments, we try to live each day according to God's ways, until we arrive at our ultimate destination which Jesus made possible by His death and resurrection: Eternal Life with God.

NOVENA DEL DIVINO NIÑO

El viernes 18 de octubre es la Novena del Divino Niño en la Capilla a las 7:00 p.m. Hay Exposición del Santísimo Sacramento y rezos de novena. Inmediatamente después, hay refrigerios ligeros en el Centro de Formación de Fe. Todos están invitados.

APARICIÓN DE FÁTIMA EL 13 DE OCTUBRE

Recordamos la aparición de Nuestra Santísima Madre a los tres niños en Fátima, Portugal en 1917. Jacinta, Lucía y Francisco sufrieron mucho por parte de las autoridades e incluso de sus familias porque se creía que estaban mintiendo. Pero los niños, aunque tan pequeños, eran muy fuertes y nunca fallaron en su testimonio.

La primera aparición fue en mayo. Nuestra Señora pidió a los niños que vinieran el día 13 de cada mes. El mensaje básico de María fue rezar el rosario, reparar el pecado y cambiar nuestras vidas. Expresó su profundo dolor porque Jesús ya estaba muy ofendido por nuestros pecados.

Durante la aparición de julio, María les dijo a los tres niños que en octubre les diría quién es y qué quiere. Dijo que entonces haría un milagro para que todos creyeran. Nuevamente, en su aparición de septiembre les recordó que en octubre realizará un milagro para que todos crean.

Se dice que ese día se reunieron en Fátima 70.000 personas. Ese día Lucía preguntó a Nuestra Señora cuál era su petición. Dijo que quería que se construyera allí una capilla en su honor. También repitió algo que pedía todos los meses: "seguir rezando el rosario todos los días". María les dijo que la guerra (Primera Guerra Mundial) terminaría pronto y los soldados regresarían a sus hogares. Luego, como había prometido, se identificó diciendo: "Soy la Señora del Rosario". Luego vino su advertencia de que la gente debía enmendar sus vidas y pedir perdón por sus pecados. No deben ofender más a Nuestro Señor, que ya está muy ofendido. Cuando María apareció en julio, les dijo a los niños que si la gente no se abstenía de ofender a Dios, habría otra guerra más terrible (la Segunda Guerra Mundial).

Cuando Nuestra Señora salía de la aparición del 13 de octubre, dirigió su atención al sol. Como testigos presenciales, Jacinta y el padre de Francisco, Ti Marto, dijeron que era extraordinario que el sol no dañara su novia. "Todo estaba en silencio y en silencio, y todos miraban hacia arriba. Luego, en cierto momento, el sol pareció dejar de girar. Luego comenzó a moverse y bailar en el cielo hasta que pareció desprenderse de su lugar y caer sobre nosotros. Fue un momento terrible".

El milagro fue visto y vivido por otras personas alejadas de la Cova. El hombre escribió cómo lo observó desde casi 40 kilómetros de distancia. Y el padre Ignacio Lorencó, un colegial de nueve años en ese momento, estaba a 11 millas. Explicó que los niños estaban afuera y presenciaron "el gran Milagro, que se podía ver claramente desde lo alto de la colina donde estaba situada mi aldea. De pronto el sol pareció descender en zigzag, amenazando la tierra. Aterrado, corrí y me escondí entre la gente que lloraba y esperaba el fin del mundo en cualquier momento."

Muchos no creyentes se convirtieron ese día incluso a distancia. El padre Lorencó señaló: "Cerca de nosotros estaba un incrédulo que había pasado la mañana burlándose de los tontos que habían ido a Fátima sólo para ver a una chica común y corriente. Ahora parecía paralizado; sus ojos estaban fijos en el sol. Después tembló de pies a cabeza y, alzando los brazos, cayó de rodillas en el barro, clamando a Nuestra Señora".

Aunque estas apariciones tuvieron lugar en 1917, el mensaje de Nuestra Señora es fiel hasta el día de hoy. Ella nos pide continuamente que recemos el Rosario, que hagamos sacrificios por nuestros pecados y los del mundo entero, y que cambiemos nuestra vida. Todos estamos en una peregrinación que comenzó con nuestro bautismo y continúa día tras día, ya que con la ayuda de Dios y especialmente Sus sacramentos, tratamos de vivir cada día según los caminos de Dios, hasta llegar a nuestro destino final que Jesús hizo posible. por Su muerte y resurrección: Vida Eterna con Dios.

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 13, 2024 GOSPEL MK 10:17-30**A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ST. MARK**

As Jesus was setting out on a journey, a man ran up, knelt down before him, and asked him, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus answered him, "Why do you call me good? No one is good but God alone. You know the commandments: *You shall not kill; you shall not commit adultery; you shall not steal; you shall not bear false witness; you shall not defraud; honor your father and your mother.*" He replied and said to him, "Teacher, all of these I have observed from my youth." Jesus, looking at him, loved him and said to him, "You are lacking in one thing. Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." At that statement his face fell, and he went away sad, for he had many possessions. Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it is for those who have wealth to enter the kingdom of God!" The disciples were amazed at his words. So Jesus again said to them in reply, "Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for one who is rich to enter the kingdom of God." They were exceedingly astonished and said among themselves, "Then who can be saved?" Jesus looked at them and said, "For human beings it is impossible, but not for God. All things are possible for God." Peter began to say to him, "We have given up everything and followed you." Jesus said, "Amen, I say to you, there is no one who has given up house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands for my sake and for the sake of the gospel who will not receive a hundred times more now in this present age: houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions, and eternal life in the age to come."

DOMINGO, 13 DE OCTUBRE 2024, EVANGELIO MC 10,17-30**LECTURA DEL SANTO EVANGELIO SEGUN SAN MARCOS**

En aquel tiempo, cuando salía Jesús al camino, se le acercó corriendo un hombre, se arrodilló ante él y le preguntó: "Maestro bueno, ¿qué debo hacer para alcanzar la vida eterna?" Jesús le contestó: "¿Por qué me llamas bueno? Nadie es bueno sino sólo Dios. Ya sabes los mandamientos: *No matarás, no cometerás adulterio, no robarás, no levantarás falso testimonio, no cometerás fraudes, honrarás a tu padre y a tu madre*". Entonces él le contestó: "Maestro, todo eso lo he cumplido desde muy joven". Jesús lo miró con amor y le dijo: "Sólo una cosa te falta: Ve y vende lo que tienes, da el dinero a los pobres y así tendrás un tesoro en los cielos. Después, ven y sígueme". Pero al oír estas palabras, el hombre se entristeció y se fue apesadumbrado, porque tenía muchos bienes. Jesús, mirando a su alrededor, dijo entonces a sus discípulos: "¡Qué difícil les va a ser a los ricos entrar en el Reino de Dios!" Los discípulos quedaron sorprendidos ante estas palabras; pero Jesús insistió: "Hijitos, ¡qué difícil es para los que confían en las riquezas, entrar en el Reino de Dios! Más fácil le es a un camello pasar por el ojo de una aguja, que a un rico entrar en el Reino de Dios". Ellos se asombraron todavía más y comentaban entre sí: "Entonces, ¿quién puede salvarse?" Jesús, mirándolos fijamente, les dijo: "Es imposible para los hombres, mas no para Dios. Para Dios todo es posible". Entonces Pedro le dijo a Jesús: "Señor, ya ves que nosotros lo hemos dejado todo para seguirte". Jesús le respondió: "Yo les aseguro: Nadie que haya dejado casa, o hermanos o hermanas, o padre o madre, o hijos o tierras, por mí y por el Evangelio, dejará de recibir, en esta vida, el ciento por uno en casas, hermanos, hermanas, madres, hijos y tierras, junto con persecuciones, y en el otro mundo, la vida eterna".

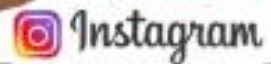
