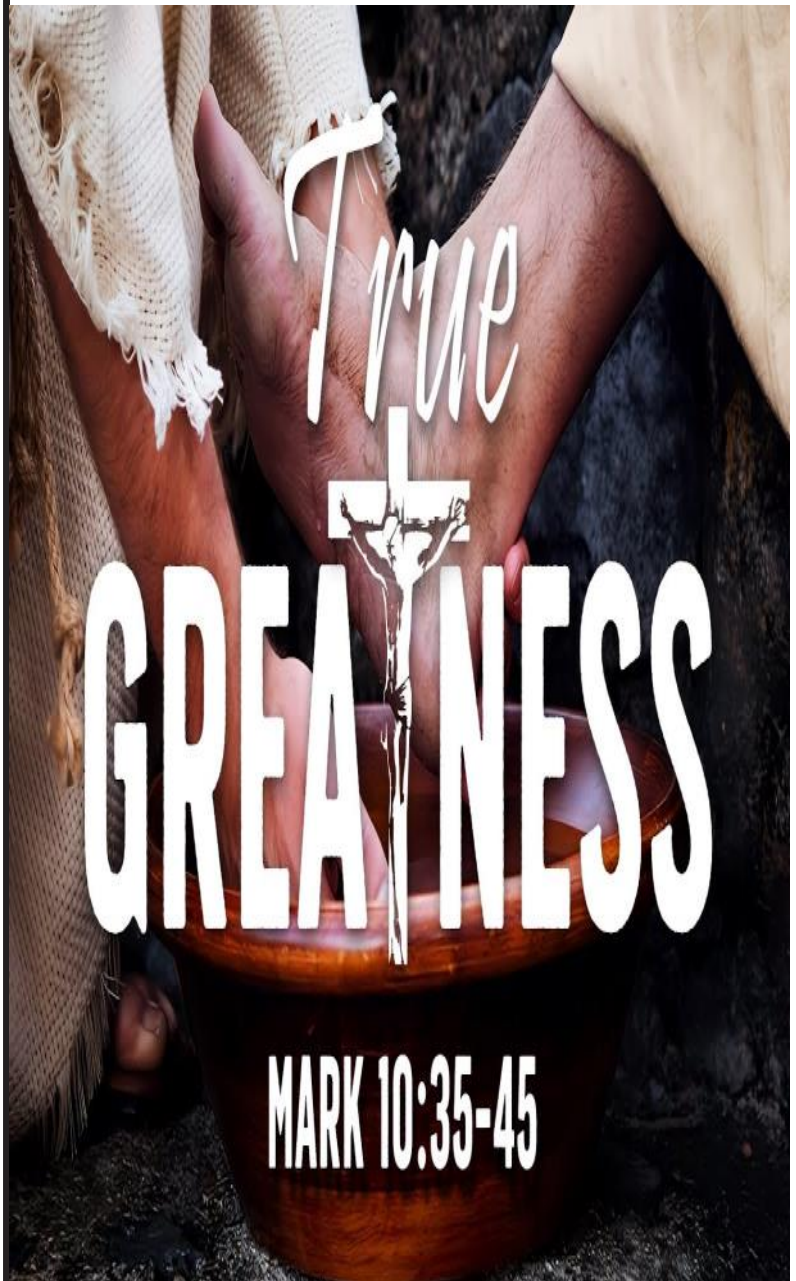

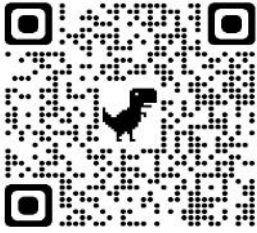

FEAST OF ST. MARGARET MARY

St. Margaret Mary was born in the village of Verosvres in Burgundy in southern France, on July 22nd , 1647. She struggled to respond to her religious vocation because her parents did not support her decision. She finally entered the Monastery of the Visitation of Paray-le-Monial on June 20th, 1671. From the very beginning of her entrance into the convent, she was given notable favors from Jesus as seen below. Jesus had destined her to a great mission. This brought her much lack of understanding, contradictions, and sufferings of spiritual and physical nature. However, St. Margaret Mary always remained faithful. She died on October 17, 1690.

The first time Jesus revealed the marvels of His Love to Margaret Mary, He said: "My divine Heart is so inflamed with love for men and for thee in particular, that being unable any longer to contain within Itself the flames of Its burning Charity, It must needs spread them abroad by thy means, and manifest Itself to them in order to enrich with the precious treasures which I discover to thee and which contain the graces of sanctification and salvation."

On another occasion, Margaret Mary said, "He discovered to me His Heart and the inexplicable wonders of His pure Love, whom He only received ingratitude and ignorance." She went on to say that Jesus told her, "What is all the more perceptible to me than all that I suffered in my Passion; all the more because if they made me some return of love, I would value very little all that I did for them, and I would like, if it was possible, still do more; but they show me only coldness and contempt for all that I did for them, and I would like, if it was possible, still do more; but they only show me coldness and contempt for all my eagerness to do them good..."

The great Revelation took place one day when Margaret Mary was in front of the Blessed Sacrament. She heard Jesus say, "Behold this Heart which has loved men so much, that it has spared nothing even to exhausting Itself in order to testify to them Its love; and in return I receive from the greater number nothing but ingratitude by reason of their irreverence and sacrileges, and by the coldness and contempt which they show Me in the Sacrament of Love."

On another occasion, while the Blessed Sacrament was exposed, feeling wholly withdrawn within myself by an extraordinary recollection of all my senses and powers, Jesus Christ, my sweet Master, presented Himself to me, all resplendent with glory with His five wounds shining like as many suns, and from every part of this Sacred Humanity flames issued especially from His adorable Bosom, which resembled an open furnace; and being opened, He disclosed to me His most loving and most amiable Heart, which was the living source of these flames."

I have been very blessed to have visited the Monastery in Paray-le-Monial on one of the occasions of my going to France to be the translator for the Chapter of my Congregation. My congregation was founded in France. Kneeling before this image in Paray-le-Monial gave me an incredible sense of Jesus' immense love for us and it stirred in my heart ever more how much we should try to love Him in word and action.

FIESTA DE SANTA MARGARITA MARÍA

Santa Margarita María nació en el pueblo de Verosvres en Borgoña, en el sur de Francia, el 22 de julio de 1647. Luchó por responder a su vocación religiosa porque sus padres no apoyaron su decisión. Finalmente entró en el Monasterio de la Visitación de Paray-le-Monial el 20 de junio de 1671. Desde el principio de su entrada en el convento, recibió notables favores de Jesús, como se ve a continuación. Jesús la había destinado a una gran misión. Esto le trajo mucha incompreensión, contradicciones y sufrimientos de naturaleza espiritual y física. Sin embargo, Santa Margarita María siempre permaneció fiel. Murió el 17 de octubre de 1690.

La primera vez que Jesús reveló las maravillas de su amor a Margarita María, dijo: "Mi divino Corazón está tan inflamado de amor por los hombres y por Ti en particular, que no pudiendo contener más en sí mismo las llamas de su ardiente Caridad, Es necesario que los difunda por tus medios y se manifieste a ellos para enriquecerlos con los preciosos tesoros que te descubro y que contienen las gracias de la santificación y de la salvación".

En otra ocasión, Margarita María dijo: "Él me descubrió Su Corazón y las inexplicables maravillas de Su Amor puro, de quien sólo recibí ingratitud e ignorancia". Continuó diciendo que Jesús le dijo: "¿Qué es tanto más perceptible para mí que todo lo que sufrí en mi Pasión? tanto más porque si me hicieran alguna devolución de amor, valoraría muy poco todo lo que hice por ellos, y me gustaría, si fuera posible, hacer todavía más; pero ellos sólo me muestran frialdad y desprecio por todo lo que hice por ellos, y quisiera, si fuera posible, hacer aún más; pero sólo me muestran frialdad y desprecio por todo mi afán de hacerles el bien..."

La gran Revelación tuvo lugar un día cuando Margarita María estaba frente al Santísimo Sacramento. Oyó a Jesús decir: "He aquí este Corazón que ha amado tanto a los hombres, que no ha escatimado nada hasta agotarse para testimoniarles su amor; y a cambio no recibo de la mayoría más que ingratitud por sus irreverencias y sacrilegios, y por la frialdad y desprecio que Me muestran en el Sacramento del Amor".

En otra ocasión, estando expuesto el Santísimo Sacramento, sintiéndome todo replegado dentro de mí por un extraordinario recuerdo de todos mis sentidos y potencias, se me presentó Jesucristo, mi dulce Maestro, todo resplandeciente de gloria, con sus cinco llagas resplandecientes como muchos soles, y de todas partes de esta Sagrada Humanidad salían llamas especialmente de Su Seno adorable, que parecía un horno abierto; y al abrirse, me reveló su amabilísimo y amabilísimo Corazón, que era fuente viva de estas llamas".

He tenido la gran suerte de haber visitado el Monasterio de Paray-le-Monial en una de las ocasiones en que fui a Francia para ser traductor del Capítulo de mi Congregación. Mi congregación fue fundada en Francia. Arrodillarme ante esta imagen en Paray-le-Monial me dio una sensación increíble del inmenso amor de Jesús por nosotros y conmovió cada vez más en mi corazón cuánto debemos tratar de amarlo en palabra y acción.

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 20, 2024 GOSPEL MK 10:35:45**A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ST. MARK**

James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to Jesus and said to him, "Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you." He replied, "What do you wish me to do for you?" They answered him, "Grant that in your glory we may sit one at your right and the other at your left." Jesus said to them, "You do not know what you are asking. Can you drink the cup that I drink or be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?" They said to him, "We can." Jesus said to them, "The cup that I drink, you will drink, and with the baptism with which I am baptized, you will be baptized; but to sit at my right or at my left is not mine to give but is for those for whom it has been prepared." When the ten heard this, they became indignant at James and John. Jesus summoned them and said to them, "You know that those who are recognized as rulers over the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones make their authority over them felt. But it shall not be so among you. Rather, whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant; whoever wishes to be first among you will be the slave of all. For the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many."

DOMINGO, 20 DE OCTUBRE 2024, EVANGELIO MC 10,35-45**LECTURA DEL SANTO EVANGELIO SEGUN SAN MARCOS**

En aquel tiempo, se acercaron a Jesús Santiago y Juan, los hijos de Zebedeo, y le dijeron: "Maestro, queremos que nos concedas lo que vamos a pedirte". Él les dijo: "¿Qué es lo que desean?" Le respondieron: "Concede que nos sentemos uno a tu derecha y otro a tu izquierda, cuando estés en tu gloria". Jesús les replicó: "No saben lo que piden. ¿Podrán pasar la prueba que yo voy a pasar y recibir el bautismo con que seré bautizado?" Le respondieron: "Sí podemos". Y Jesús les dijo: "Ciertamente pasarán la prueba que yo voy a pasar y recibirán el bautismo con que yo seré bautizado; pero eso de sentarse a mi derecha o a mi izquierda no me toca a mí concederlo; eso es para quienes está reservado". Cuando los otros diez apóstoles oyeron esto, se indignaron contra Santiago y Juan. Jesús reunió entonces a los Doce y les dijo: "Ya saben que los jefes de las naciones las gobiernan como si fueran sus dueños y los poderosos las oprimen. Pero no debe ser así entre ustedes. Al contrario: el que quiera ser grande entre ustedes que sea su servidor, y el que quiera ser el primero, que sea el esclavo de todos, así como el Hijo del hombre, que no ha venido a que lo sirvan, sino a servir y a dar su vida por la redención de todos".
