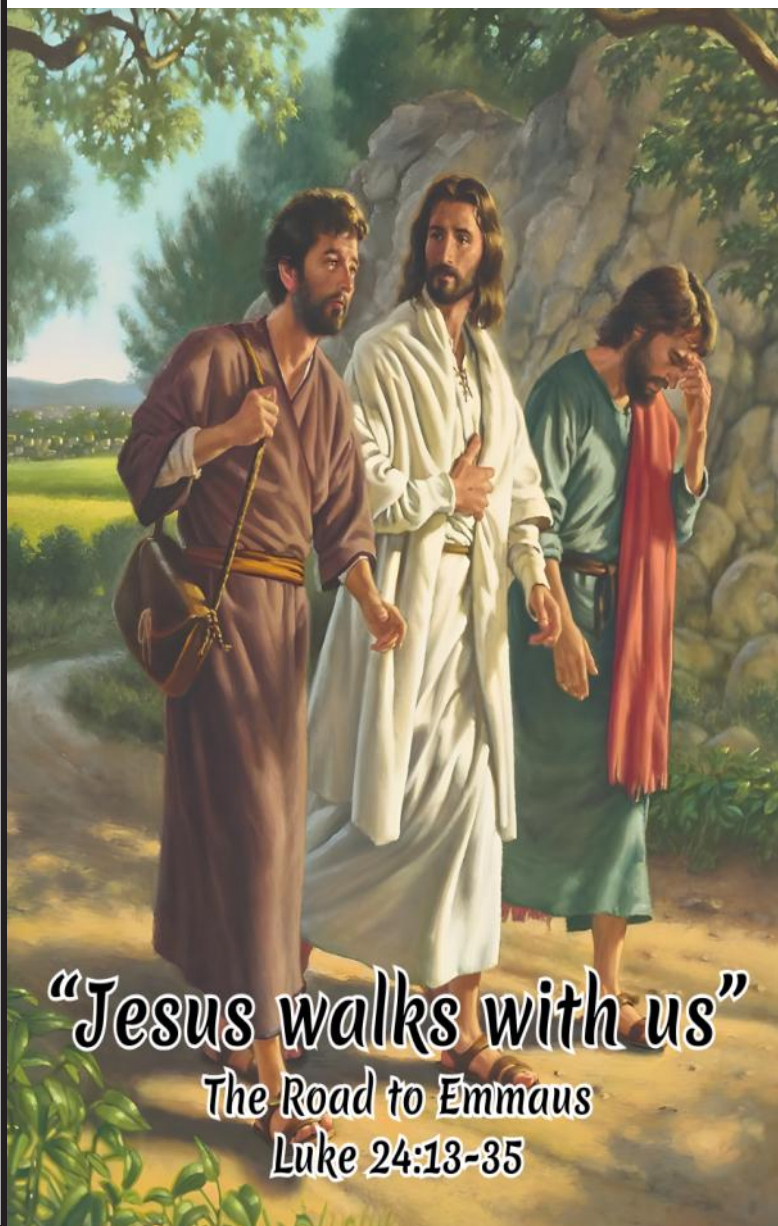

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Last Sunday the Church celebrated the great feast of Divine Mercy Sunday which occurs every year the Sunday following Easter Sunday. This devotion originated in 1930s Poland through the spiritual experiences of Sister Faustina Kowalska, a Sister of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. Between 1931 and 1938, in her diary, Divine "Mercy in My Soul", Sister Faustina recorded visions and messages that she had received from Jesus. This became the foundation of this great devotion. Jesus revealed His desire to pour out mercy on all souls, especially sinners, and asked St. Faustina to spread this message all over the world. The devotion gained tremendous recognition when Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina in 2000 and established Divine Mercy Sunday on the Second Sunday of Easter.

The Divine Mercy devotion strongly emphasizes God's boundless love and compassion, showing that His mercy surpasses all sins and is available to everyone who trusts in Him and seeks His forgiveness. This devotion teaches that desires everyone to approach Him with repentance, receive His mercy, and extend mercy to others, reflecting Christ's love in daily life. Rooted in the Gospel, this devotion encourages believers to live daily with a spirit of mercy and full trust in Jesus. Jesus asked Sister Faustina to have an image made of this apparition with the signature, "Jesus, I trust in You".

There are key spiritual practices involved in this devotion. There is the Divine Mercy Image of Jesus with red and white rays flowing from His heart, symbolizing blood and water, with the inscription, "Jesus, I trust in You". Many know well the Divine Mercy Chaplet which is a prayer using rosary beads, invoking God's mercy for oneself and the world, especially at 3:00pm, which is known as the Hour of Mercy. It recalls Jesus' death on the cross. However, this Chaplet may be prayed at any other hour. The Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday and ends the day before Divine Mercy Sunday. The Novena consists of specific intentions for priests, sinners, and the whole world. On the actual Feast of Divine Mercy one may receive a plenary indulgence by going to confession, receive Holy Communion, and pray for the intentions of the Pope.

The essential significance of this devotion is that God's mercy is infinite, no sin is too great for His forgiveness, and trust in Jesus is most essential. Jesus promised extraordinary graces to those who practice this devotion faithfully, making it a powerful way to experience His mercy personally and share it with others. When people share with me some of their worries, concerns, preoccupations, etc., I almost always ask them to repeat very often, "Jesus, I trust in You". Jesus' love for each one of us is far beyond what we imagine, and He wants so much to be with us. TRUST IN HIM!!!

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

Last Saturday, April 11th, our youngsters preparing to receive the sacrament of Confirmation had their Retreat. The main theme of the day was how do the sacraments of Baptism, Holy Communion, Reconciliation, and Confirmation help us to live our daily lives according to God's ways. For the sacrament of Baptism, you see below, one of our confirmands dressed in a white robe with a good number of slips of paper pinned to the robe. On each slip was one of the values that we are asked to live as children of God. When an adult is baptized, a white robe is put on her/him symbolizing that they are putting on Christ, meaning we must begin to live, think, act, etc. as Jesus has taught us.

After lunch we had a very peaceful, prayerful prayer time before Jesus in the Monstrance. Believe me, you could not hear a pin drop! After this beautiful experience, our youngsters approached the sacrament of reconciliation. It was truly a blessed day! Please pray for them that their receiving the sacrament of Confirmation will strengthen their faith and determination to follow the Lord.

DOMINGO DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

El domingo pasado, la Iglesia celebró la gran fiesta del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, la cual tiene lugar cada año el domingo siguiente al Domingo de Pascua. Esta devoción tuvo su origen en la Polonia de la década de 1930, a través de las experiencias espirituales de la Hermana Faustina Kowalska, religiosa de la Congregación de las Hermanas de Nuestra Señora de la Misericordia. Entre 1931 y 1938, en su diario titulado *La Divina Misericordia en mi alma*, la hermana Faustina registró las visiones y los mensajes que había recibido de Jesús. Esto se convirtió en el fundamento de esta gran devoción. Jesús reveló su deseo de derramar su misericordia sobre todas las almas —especialmente sobre los pecadores— y pidió a santa Faustina que difundiera este mensaje por todo el mundo. La devoción alcanzó un reconocimiento extraordinario cuando el papa Juan Pablo II canonizó a santa Faustina en el año 2000 y estableció el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia para el segundo domingo de Pascua.

La devoción a la Divina Misericordia pone un fuerte énfasis en el amor y la compasión ilimitados de Dios, mostrando que su misericordia trasciende todos los pecados y está al alcance de todo aquel que confía en Él y busca su perdón. Esta devoción enseña que Dios desea que todos nos acerquemos a Él con arrepentimiento, recibamos su misericordia y, a su vez, mostremos misericordia hacia los demás, reflejando así el amor de Cristo en nuestra vida cotidiana. Enraizada en el Evangelio, esta devoción alienta a los creyentes a vivir cada día con un espíritu de misericordia y plena confianza en Jesús. Jesús pidió a la Hermana Faustina que mandara realizar una imagen de esta aparición, acompañada de la jaculatoria: «Jesús, en Ti confío».

Existen prácticas espirituales fundamentales asociadas a esta devoción. Una de ellas es la imagen de la Divina Misericordia de Jesús, de cuyo corazón brotan rayos rojos y blancos —que simbolizan la sangre y el agua—, junto con la inscripción: «Jesús, en Ti confío». Muchos conocen bien la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia: una oración que se reza con las cuentas del rosario para invocar la misericordia de Dios para uno mismo y para el mundo entero, especialmente a las 3:00 p. m., hora conocida como la «Hora de la Misericordia», la cual conmemora la muerte de Jesús en la cruz. No obstante, esta Coronilla puede rezarse a cualquier otra hora del día. La Novena a la Divina Misericordia comienza el Viernes Santo y concluye la víspera del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Dicha Novena consta de intenciones específicas dirigidas a los sacerdotes, a los pecadores y al mundo entero. En la propia Fiesta de la Divina Misericordia, uno puede recibir una indulgencia plenaria acudiendo a confesarse, recibiendo la Sagrada Comunión y rezando por las intenciones del Papa.

El significado esencial de esta devoción es que la misericordia de Dios es infinita, que ningún pecado es demasiado grande para Su perdón y que la confianza en Jesús es lo más fundamental. Jesús prometió gracias extraordinarias a aquellos que practiquen esta devoción con fidelidad, convirtiéndola en una forma poderosa de experimentar Su misericordia personalmente y compartirla con los demás. Cuando las personas comparten conmigo algunas de sus inquietudes, preocupaciones, desvelos, etc., casi siempre les pido que repitan muy a menudo: «Jesús, en Ti confío». El amor de Jesús por cada uno de nosotros trasciende con creces lo que podemos imaginar, y Él desea profundamente estar con nosotros. ¡¡¡CONFÍEN EN ÉL!!!

SACRAMENTO DE LA CONFIRMACIÓN

El sábado pasado, 11 de abril, nuestros jóvenes que se preparan para recibir el sacramento de la Confirmación tuvieron su retiro. El tema principal del día fue cómo los sacramentos del Bautismo, la Sagrada Comunión, la Reconciliación y la Confirmación nos ayudan a vivir nuestra vida cotidiana según los caminos de Dios. En relación con el sacramento del Bautismo —como pueden ver a continuación—, uno de nuestros confirmandos se vistió con una túnica blanca a la que llevaba prendidos un buen número de pequeños papeles. En cada uno de esos papeles figuraba uno de los valores que se nos pide vivir como hijos de Dios. Cuando un adulto es bautizado, se le impone una túnica blanca, simbolizando que se está «revistiendo de Cristo»; esto significa que debemos comenzar a vivir, pensar, actuar, etc., tal como Jesús nos ha enseñado.

Después del almuerzo, tuvimos un momento de oración muy sereno y recogido ante Jesús en la Custodia. Créanme: ¡no se oía ni el vuelo de una mosca! Tras esta hermosa experiencia, nuestros jóvenes se acercaron al sacramento de la Reconciliación. ¡Fue verdaderamente un día bendecido! Por favor, recen por ellos para que la recepción del sacramento de la Confirmación fortalezca su fe y su determinación de seguir al Señor.

SUNDAY, APRIL 19, 2026 GOSPEL LUKE 24:13-35**READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE**

That very day, the first day of the week, two of Jesus' disciples were going to a village seven miles from Jerusalem called Emmaus, and they were conversing about all the things that had occurred.

And it happened that while they were conversing and debating, Jesus himself drew near and walked with them, but their eyes were prevented from recognizing him. He asked them, "What are you discussing as you walk along?"

They stopped, looking downcast. One of them, named Cleopas, said to him in reply, "Are you the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know of the things that have taken place there in these days?" And he replied to them, "What sort of things?" They said to him, "The things that happened to Jesus the Nazarene, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, how our chief priests and rulers both handed him over to a sentence of death and crucified him. But we were hoping that he would be the one to redeem Israel; and besides all this, it is now the third day since this took place. Some women from our group, however, have astounded us: they were at the tomb early in the morning and did not find his body; they came back and reported that they had indeed seen a vision of angels who announced that he was alive. Then some of those with us went to the tomb and found things just as the women had described, but him they did not see."

And he said to them, "Oh, how foolish you are! How slow of heart to believe all that the prophets spoke! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" Then beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them what referred to him in all the Scriptures.

As they approached the village to which they were going, he gave the impression that he was going on farther. But they urged him, "Stay with us, for it is nearly evening and the day is almost over." So he went in to stay with them. And it happened that, while he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight. Then they said to each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?"

So they set out at once and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven and those with them who were saying, "The Lord has truly been raised and has appeared to Simon!" Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of bread.

DOMINGO 19 DE ABRIL DE 2026 LUCAS 24, 13-25**LECTURA DEL SANTO EVANGELIO SEGÚN SAN JUAN**

El mismo día de la resurrección, iban dos de los discípulos hacia un pueblo llamado Emaús, situado a unos once kilómetros de Jerusalén, y comentaban todo lo que había sucedido.

Mientras conversaban y discutían, Jesús se les acercó y comenzó a caminar con ellos; pero los ojos de los dos discípulos estaban velados y no lo reconocieron. Él les preguntó: "¿De qué cosas vienen hablando, tan llenos de tristeza?"

Uno de ellos, llamado Cleofás, le respondió: "¿Eres tú el único forastero que no sabe lo que ha sucedido estos días en Jerusalén?" Él les preguntó: "¿Qué cosa?" Ellos le respondieron: "Lo de Jesús el nazareno, que era un profeta poderoso en obras y palabras, ante Dios y ante todo el pueblo. Cómo los sumos sacerdotes y nuestros jefes lo entregaron para que lo condenaran a muerte, y lo crucificaron. Nosotros esperábamos que él sería el libertador de Israel, y sin embargo, han pasado ya tres días desde que estas cosas sucedieron. Es cierto que algunas mujeres de nuestro grupo nos han desconcertado, pues fueron de madrugada al sepulcro, no encontraron el cuerpo y llegaron contando que se les habían aparecido unos ángeles, que les dijeron que estaba vivo. Algunos de nuestros compañeros fueron al sepulcro y hallaron todo como habían dicho las mujeres, pero a él no lo vieron".

Entonces Jesús les dijo: "¿Qué insensatos son ustedes y qué duros de corazón para creer todo lo anunciado por los profetas! ¿Acaso no era necesario que el Mesías padeciera todo esto y así entrara en su gloria?" Y comenzando por Moisés y siguiendo con todos los profetas, les explicó todos los pasajes de la Escritura que se referían a él.

Ya cerca del pueblo a donde se dirigían, él hizo como que iba más lejos; pero ellos le insistieron, diciendo: "Quédate con nosotros, porque ya es tarde y pronto va a oscurecer". Y entró para quedarse con ellos. Cuando estaban a la mesa, tomó un pan, pronunció la bendición, lo partió y se lo dio. Entonces se les abrieron los ojos y lo reconocieron, pero él se les desapareció. Y ellos se decían el uno al otro: "¿Con razón nuestro corazón ardía, mientras nos hablaba por el camino y nos explicaba las Escrituras!"

Se levantaron inmediatamente y regresaron a Jerusalén, donde encontraron reunidos a los Once con sus compañeros, los cuales les dijeron: "De veras ha resucitado el Señor y se le ha aparecido a Simón". Entonces ellos contaron lo que les había pasado en el camino y cómo lo habían reconocido al partir el pan.

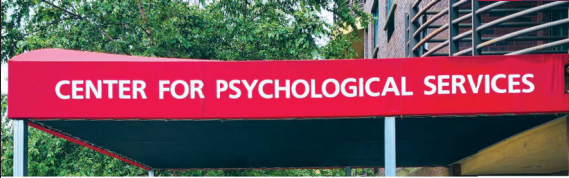
