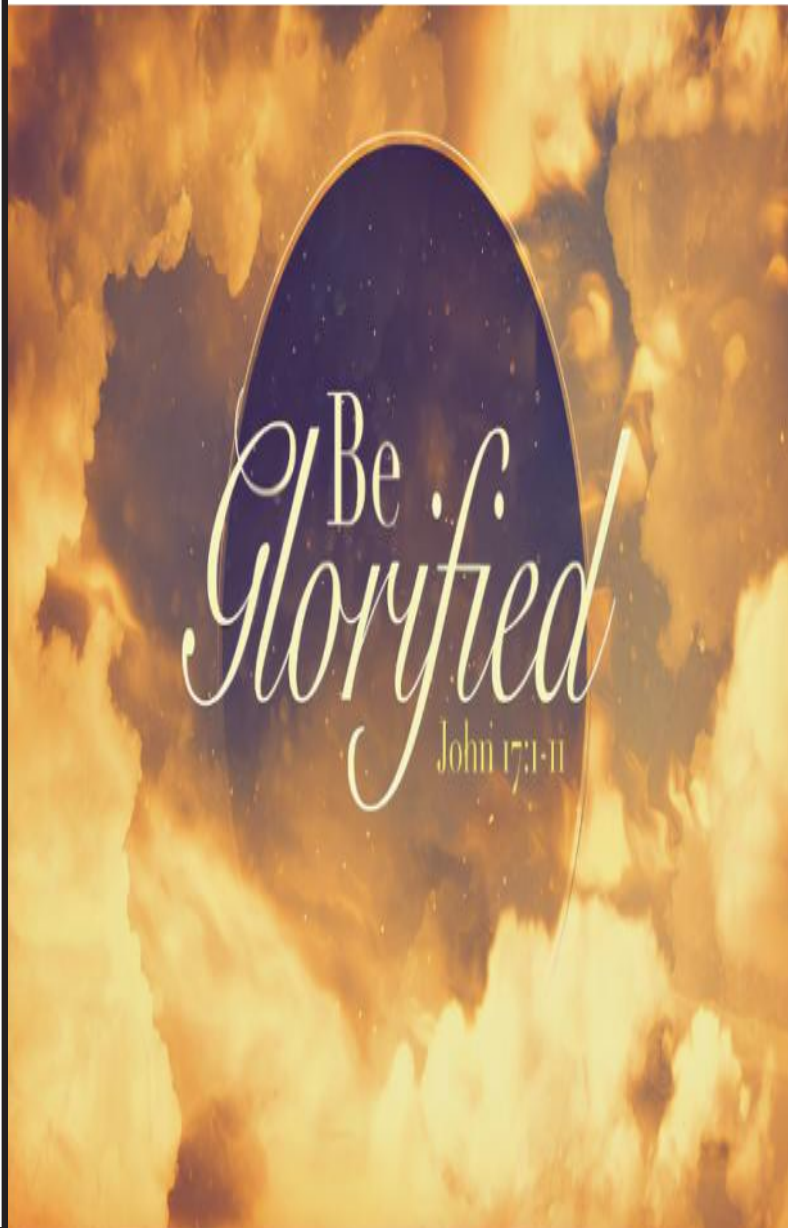

### **ASCENSION THURSDAY**

This past Thursday, 40 days since the Resurrection of Jesus, the Church celebrated the Ascension of Our Lord into heaven. The readings throughout these past 40 days have told us of many times and ways that the Resurrected Jesus appeared to His apostles and disciples indicating that He indeed is the Promised Messiah, that He is the One who died on the cross to make our new life with Him possible. As the days for His going back to the Father were coming near, Jesus began more forcibly to speak of entrusting His mission to them, that they may continue to teach and preach about how to live out the lives of Jesus' followers that one day they will live with Him forever.

The apostles were left fearful, how were they to do this? Jesus was going to leave them, and yet they had to continue His mission!!! How??? Jesus promised them that He was going to send them the Holy Spirit who would help them understand all that was not yet clear to them and be with them always, giving them all that they would need to be faithful to their mission. Jesus asked them to return to where He had held His Last Supper to pray for the coming of the Holy Spirit. This is the origin of the Catholic Tradition of novenas. Thus, the nine-day novena of the Holy Spirit began on Friday, May 15th, at 11:30am in the Church and will continue each day until Saturday, May 23rd.

### **GREAT FEAST OF PENTECOST**

With the Vigil of Pentecost, we begin this great celebration. Pentecost, 50 days after Easter, marks the birthday of the Catholic Church. Once the Holy Spirit came upon the apostles on Pentecost, the timid apostles began preaching and teaching with great vim, with no fear! We are told that 3000 people asked to be baptized that very first day! We should keep in mind that throughout Jesus' three years of making God known and the Way that will lead to eternal life, people were not sure who He really was. Now, once the Holy Spirit came and they were truly enlightened, then they realized that He indeed was the Savior, the Promised Messiah, and asked to be baptized.

Pope Leo XIV has been asking for prayers for peace in our very troubled world. On Saturday, May 23rd, from 7:30pm to 8:30pm, we will have a bi-lingual Holy Hour praying for peace. May the Holy Spirit strongly touch the hearts especially those who are in positions to do much more to bring peace for all peoples, and that they be open to His inspirations. It is also an important opportunity that we pray for peace in our families. We all know the hymn, "Let There Be Peace on Earth and Let it Begin with Me"!

At the end of this Holy Hour, we will sing "Happy Birthday, Catholic Church" and each person will take home a piece of its birthday cake!

Because we are baptized, each one of us is also called to be part of continuing Jesus' mission here and now. At all the Masses on May 23rd and May 24, all the ministries: lectors, extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist, choir, ushers, and catechists will renew their commitment to their specific ministry. May we also ask if possible, we flood our parish with something red: shirt, blouse, scarf, pin, tie, etc.

### JUEVES DE LA ASCENSIÓN

El pasado jueves—40 días después de la Resurrección de Jesús—la Iglesia celebró la Ascensión de Nuestro Señor a los cielos. Las lecturas a lo largo de estos últimos 40 días nos han relatado las muchas ocasiones y formas en que Jesús Resucitado se apareció a sus apóstoles y discípulos, indicando que Él es, en verdad, el Mesías Prometido; que Él es Aquel que murió en la cruz para hacer posible nuestra nueva vida junto a Él. A medida que se acercaban los días de su regreso al Padre, Jesús comenzó a hablar con mayor énfasis sobre la encomienda de su misión a ellos, para que continuaran enseñando y predicando sobre cómo vivir la vida propia de los seguidores de Jesús, quienes un día vivirán con Él para siempre.

Los apóstoles quedaron temerosos: ¿cómo podrían llevar esto a cabo? ¿Jesús iba a dejarlos, y sin embargo ellos debían continuar su misión! ¿¿¿Cómo??? Jesús les prometió que les enviaría el Espíritu Santo, quien les ayudaría a comprender todo aquello que aún no les resultaba claro y estaría siempre con ellos, otorgándoles todo lo que necesitaran para ser fieles a su misión. Jesús les pidió que regresaran al lugar donde había celebrado su Última Cena para orar por la venida del Espíritu Santo. Este es el origen de la tradición católica de las novenas. Así pues, la novena de nueve días al Espíritu Santo comenzó el viernes 15 de mayo, a las 11:30 a. m., en la iglesia, y continuará cada día hasta el sábado 23 de mayo.

### GRAN FIESTA DE PENTECOSTÉS

Con la Vigilia de Pentecostés, damos inicio a esta gran celebración. Pentecostés—50 días después de la Pascua—marca el nacimiento de la Iglesia Católica. Una vez que el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre los apóstoles en Pentecostés, aquellos apóstoles, antes tímidos, comenzaron a predicar y enseñar con gran vigor, ¡sin temor alguno! ¡Se nos relata que 3000 personas pidieron ser bautizadas en ese mismísimo primer día! Debemos tener presente que, a lo largo de los tres años en que Jesús se dedicó a dar a conocer a Dios y el Camino que conduce a la vida eterna, la gente no estaba segura de quién era Él realmente. Ahora, una vez que llegó el Espíritu Santo y fueron verdaderamente iluminados, comprendieron que Él era, en efecto, el Salvador, el Mesías Prometido, y pidieron ser bautizados.

El Papa León XIV ha estado pidiendo oraciones por la paz en nuestro mundo, tan lleno de conflictos. El sábado 23 de mayo, de 7:30 p. m. a 8:30 p. m., tendremos una Hora Santa bilingüe para rezar por la paz. Que el Espíritu Santo toque profundamente los corazones, especialmente los de aquellos que ocupan posiciones desde las cuales pueden hacer mucho más para traer la paz a todos los pueblos, y que estos se muestren abiertos a Sus inspiraciones. Es también una oportunidad importante para que oremos por la paz en nuestras propias familias. ¡Todos conocemos el himno: «Que haya paz en la Tierra y que comience conmigo»!

Al finalizar esta Hora Santa, cantaremos «Feliz cumpleaños, Iglesia Católica», ¡y cada persona se llevará a casa un trozo del pastel de cumpleaños!

Dado que hemos sido bautizados, cada uno de nosotros está llamado también a participar en la continuación de la misión de Jesús, aquí y ahora. En todas las Misas de los días 23 y 24 de mayo, todos los ministerios—lectores, ministros extraordinarios de la Eucaristía, coro, ujieres y catequistas—renovarán su compromiso con su ministerio específico. Asimismo, les pedimos que, si les es posible, inunden nuestra parroquia con algún detalle de color rojo: camisa, blusa, bufanda, prendedor, corbata, etc.

Jesus raised his eyes to heaven and said, “Father, the hour has come. Give glory to your son, so that your son may glorify you, just as you gave him authority over all people, so that your son may give eternal life to all you gave him. Now this is eternal life, that they should know you, the only true God, and the one whom you sent, Jesus Christ.

I glorified you on earth by accomplishing the work that you gave me to do. Now glorify me, Father, with you, with the glory that I had with you before the world began.

“I revealed your name to those whom you gave me out of the world. They belonged to you, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. Now they know that everything you gave me is from you, because the words you gave to me I have given to them, and they accepted them and truly understood that I came from you, and they have believed that you sent me.

I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for the ones you have given me, because they are yours, and everything of mine is yours and everything of yours is mine, and I have been glorified in them. And now I will no longer be in the world, but they are in the world, while I am coming to you.”

**DOMINGO 17 DE MAYO DE 2026 JUAN 17,1-11****LECTURA DEL SANTO EVANGELIO SEGÚN SAN JUAN**

En aquel tiempo, Jesús levantó los ojos al cielo y dijo: “Padre, ha llegado la hora. Glorifica a tu Hijo, para que tu Hijo también te glorifique, y por el poder que le diste sobre toda la humanidad, dé la vida eterna a cuantos le has confiado. La vida eterna consiste en que te conozcan a ti, único Dios verdadero, y a Jesucristo, a quien tú has enviado.

Yo te he glorificado sobre la tierra, llevando a cabo la obra que me encomendaste. Ahora, Padre, glorifícame en ti con la gloria que tenía, antes de que el mundo existiera.

He manifestado tu nombre a los hombres que tú tomaste del mundo y me diste. Eran tuyos y tú me los diste. # REFLECTION

- I have to work at this, Lord. The description of eternal life is stark. To know the only true God is beyond my imagination. Do we, in our glorified bodies, leave behind our senses of smell, taste, touch, hearing, vision, that delight us now and seem to be harbingers of better things to come? Somehow the knowledge of the one true God must bring all these joys to a new level.
- Jesus wanted the Father to show some sign to his disciples before his death that God was with him, and that he was following the way of God even to the cross. Later on they would hear a voice from heaven, glorifying the name of Jesus, giving security and hope to the disciples at the hour of Jesus' death.
- Jesus wants me to have eternal life and describes what that life is: to know God and to know Jesus. As I grow in knowledge of God I begin to taste in the eternal life Jesus promises. I thank God for the light I have, for the quiet revelations and for the personal inspirations that have been given to me.
- The letters AMDG are an invitation to live Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam, to the greater glory of God. I think of how my words, actions and talents reflect God's glory and imagine myself signing them, AMDG.

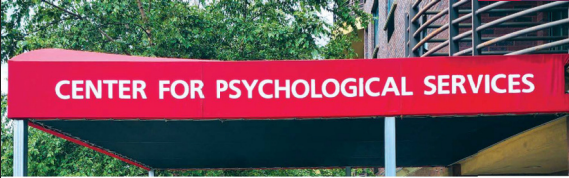
