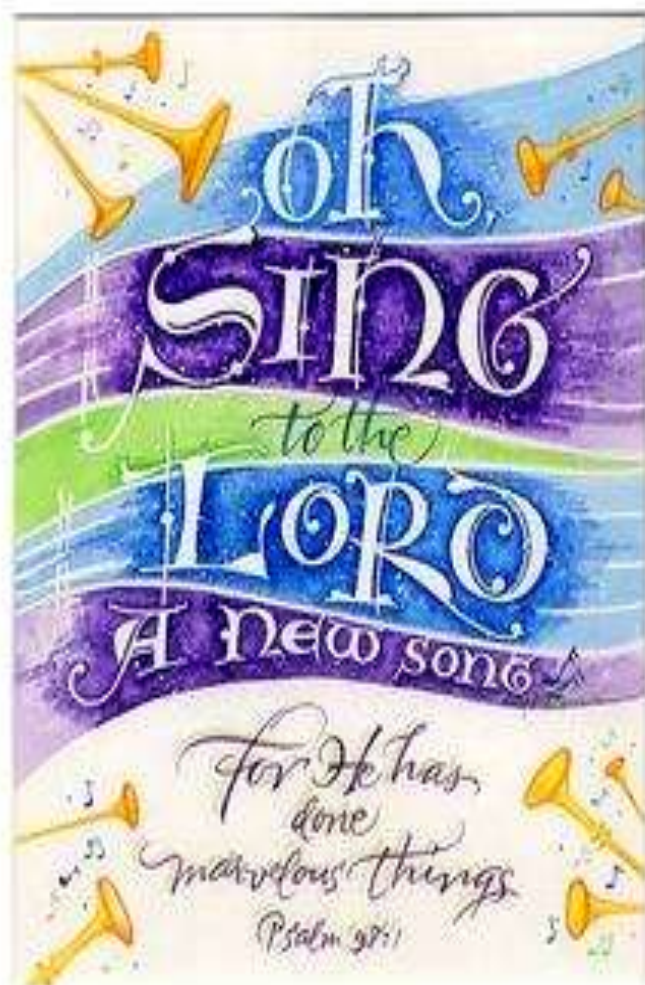

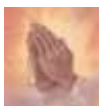

From the Pastor's Desk....

This Sunday the Church reminds us of the importance of showing gratitude to God. We have many reasons to return to God with our heart full of gratitude to Him. Thanksgiving is the key to joy.

In today's first reading, we heard the story of Naaman who was a five-star general in the Syrian army, but he was also a leper. He was told by his prophet Elisha to go and bathe in the Jordan River seven times in order to be healed. He did that and was cleansed of his leprosy. This cure was more than the physical. It had reached his whole person.

Naaman took some Israelite earth to build an altar for the God of Israel in his own hometown in Syria. Why does Naaman haul away a pile of dirt? Naaman had experienced the power and the mercy of the God of Israel and had come to believe that this was the only God, the universal God. He wanted to give thanks and praise for his cure by offering sacrifice on an altar built on soil from Israel.

In today's Gospel ten lepers requested Jesus to heal them. Nine of them were Jews but one of them was a Samaritan. After their cure only one "*Turned back, praising God at the top of his voice, and threw himself at the feet of Jesus and thanked him.*" Jesus told him something like this, "You are welcome, I accept your thanks...it is your faith, a faith of which you are barely aware, that has saved you.....continue on your way with my blessing."

It is the story of nine people who failed to thank Jesus for his compassion and healing. Many of us hardly have time to show gratitude to God for what he has done for us. We can almost hear the note of disappointment in Jesus' voice when He asks the one who came to thank him; where are the other nine? This story puts this question to each one of us; Am I the Samaritan...or one of the nine?

Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that it is a duty and an expression of gratitude to visit the Blessed Sacrament, to thank Jesus for his gifts to you (CCC #1418). *May we follow the example of Naaman and the Samaritan and be grateful to God for the many gifts we have received from Him.* We also learn from the Blessed Virgin Mary, our Mother who confesses with gratitude that God has done great things for her.

ST. NICK'S 100th ANNIVERSARY

In 1916, plans were made to start a parish in the area of the Queensboro Hospital for Communicable Diseases, which is the location of Queens General Medical Center. Property was purchased in January of 1917 and a church was built on the corner of Parsons Blvd. and Union Turnpike by October of that same year. The area and the parish have developed into a diversified community with people of many different languages and cultures.

This is St. Nick's today!

Come As you Are I Love You

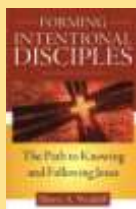
Do you want to experience a piece of heaven on earth?
