From the Pastor's Desk....

Prayer is the key to success.

In the first reading (Exodus 17: 8 -13), we are presented with a beautiful example of the need for prayer and mutual spiritual support. Israel was under attack...Joshua was going to lead the defending army...Moses would remain behind and pray for the persecuted Israelites.

As the scene unfolded it became clear that Moses too needed the support of others in order for him to persist in his prayer and not lose heart. When Moses held up his hands in prayer the Israelites prevailed; and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed. Moses' brother Aaron and his friend helped him to keep his hands raised in prayer and the Israelites won the battle.

We learn from this historical event that like Moses every religious leader must lead his people spiritually. Leaders do need help, Moses was not able to do the job alone. Aaron and Hur are needed in every age and time to win the battle against evil. It is also important to remember that **we lose when we stop praying**.

In today's Gospel, Jesus further underscores the importance of continuous prayer. Through the parable of the widow, Jesus teaches us to be consistent and persevere in prayer at all times. Never give up on prayer. It is the key to success in our mission.

May God help us to support each other's arms in prayer and to pray with and for each other!

World Mission Sunday

Today is World Mission Sunday. Pope Francis reminds us that on this World Mission Sunday, 2016, all of us are invited to "go out" as missionary disciples, each generously offering their talents, creativity, wisdom and experience in order to bring the message of God's tenderness and compassion to the entire human family.

All peoples and cultures have the right to receive the message of salvation which is God's gift to every person. Missionaries know from experience that the Gospel of forgiveness and mercy can bring joy and reconciliation, justice and peace. ST. NICK'S 100th ANNIVERSARY

In 1916, plans were made to start a parish in the area of the Queensboro Hospital for Communicable Diseases, which is the location of Queens General Medical Center. Property was purchased in January of 1917 and a church was built on the corner of Parsons Blvd. and Union Turnpike by October of that same year. The area and the parish have developed into a diversified community with people of many different languages and cultures.

This is St. Nick's today!

Come As you Are I Love You

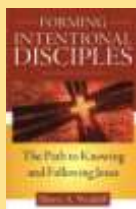
Do you want to experience a piece of heaven on earth?
