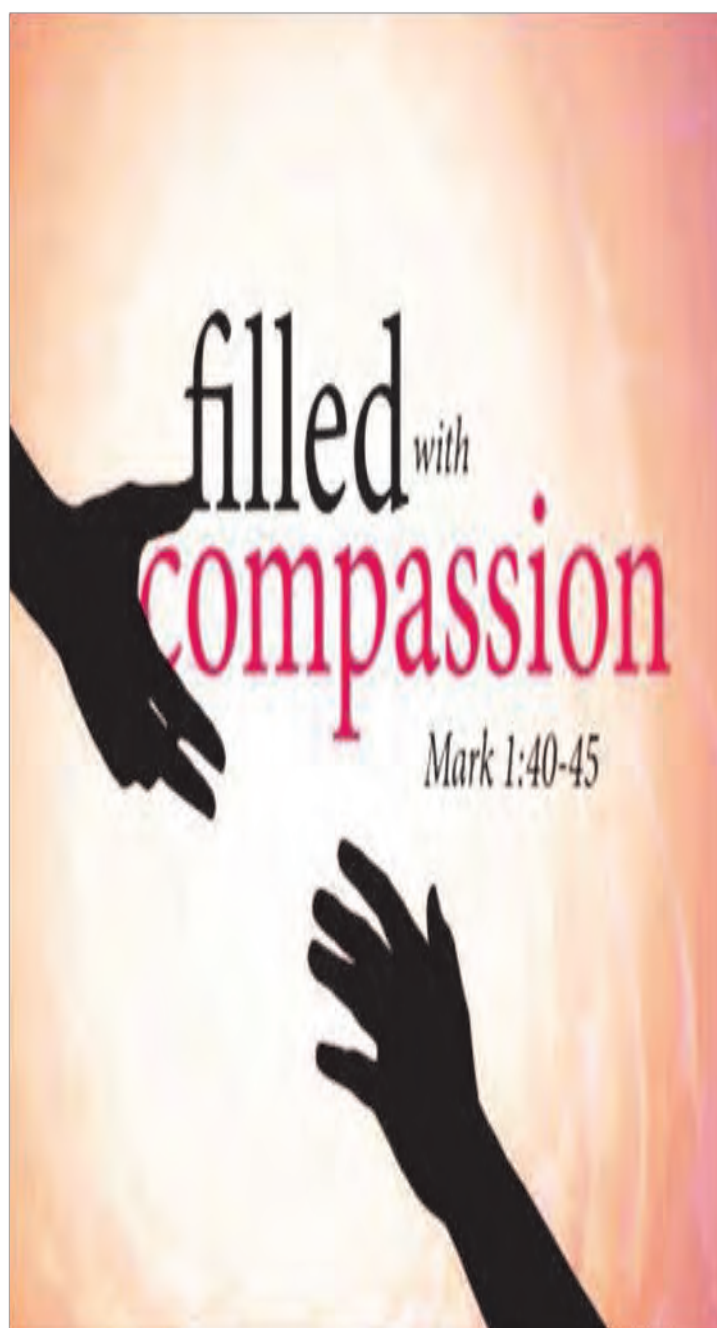

SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2021 GOSPEL MARK 1:40-45

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark

A leper came to Jesus and kneeling down begged him and said, "If you wish, you can make me clean." Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, and said to him, **"I do will it. Be made clean."** The leprosy left him immediately, and he was made clean. Then, warning him sternly, he dismissed him at once.

He said to him, "See that you tell no one anything, but go, show yourself to the priest and offer for your cleansing what Moses prescribed; that will be proof for them."

The man went away and began to publicize the whole matter. He spread the report abroad so that it was impossible for Jesus to enter a town openly. He remained outside in deserted places, and people kept coming to him from everywhere.

DOMINGO, FEBRERO 14, 2021 EVANGELIO MARCOS 1:40-45

Lectura del santo Evangelio según San Marcos

En aquel tiempo, se le acercó a Jesús un leproso para suplicarle de rodillas: "Si tú quieres, puedes curarme". Jesús se compadeció de él, y extendiendo la mano, lo tocó y le dijo: "¡Sí quiero: Sana!" Inmediatamente se le quitó la lepra y quedó limpio.

Al despedirlo, Jesús le mandó con severidad: **"No se lo cuentes a nadie; pero para que conste, ve a presentarte al sacerdote y ofrece por tu purificación lo prescrito por Moisés"**.

Pero aquel hombre comenzó a divulgar tanto el hecho, que Jesús no podía ya entrar abiertamente en la ciudad, sino que se quedaba fuera, en lugares solitarios, a donde acudían a él de todas partes.

Gospel Reflection...

The leper doesn't reckon: "I've tried others for a cure; now I'll try Jesus". No, for this leper there is no question: his faith in Jesus' power is absolute.

And he doesn't even seem to think: "I'll hold it against you if you don't help me" – he seems ready to go on accepting his lot; so his faith is deep enough to leave Jesus in perfect freedom: to say to Jesus, "If you choose" – and to mean it.

Deeply moved, Jesus put out his hand and touched him. Jesus, the poet of God's compassion, spoke in parables, but also in actions. He healed the sick and freed people from evil, brokenness and rejection. God's mercy was not just a beautiful idea. In Jesus, God is the active champion of the suffering.

Jesus, the compassionate one, enters fully into the human mess of our lives. Leprosy was the most dreaded of diseases in his day. Jesus risks conflict and division for the sake of a nobody who was suffering exclusion and isolation from family and community.

Jesus affirms the desire of the man with leprosy: his 'Certainly I want to,' is his response to our desire for what is truly for our growth and wellbeing. (Sacred Space)
